Statutory Requirements: Elementary and Secondary Education Act: Section 1401

State Guidance:

Title I, Part D's purpose is to improve educational services for children and youth in local, tribal, and state institutions so that children and youth can meet the same challenging state academic standards that all children in the state are expected to meet.

For this item, the SAU must demonstrate that their curriculum is aligned to academic state standards. This is to ensure that the SAU is meeting the intent and purpose of Title I, Part D.
