Background

The Title IV, Part A: Student Support and Academic Enrichment grant program is a multi-purpose block grant designed to help state education agencies (SEAs) and local education agencies (LEAs) improve student academic achievement by:

- Sec. 4106: Providing all students with access to a **Well-Rounded Education**;
- Sec. 4107: Improving school conditions for student learning by fostering **Safe and Healthy Students**; and
- Sec. 4108: Advancing the **Effective Use of Technology** in classrooms to support learning and digital literacy of all students.

LEAs determine the programs and activities that will be carried out with Title IV, Part A funds in order to best meet the needs of those in their local school communities.

Purpose

In accordance with the §4104(a)(2) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), the Maine Department of Education must publicly report the following information on an annual basis:

- A. How Title IV, Part A funds made available to local education agencies (LEAs) across the state have been expended; and
- B. The extent to which LEAs have demonstrated progress toward meeting their annual goals and outcomes for their programs and activities funded through the Title IV, Part A program.

This report serves to provide the public with access to the information outlined above for each LEA that received an allocation of Title IV, Part A funds during the reporting period.

Overview

The data in this report has been provided directly by LEAs that received Title IV, Part A funds during the reporting period as part of an annual performance reporting process. Section A of the report provides a breakdown of how each LEA expended funds under the various content areas for the program, while section B of the report illustrates the extent to which LEAs met the proposed goals of their Title IV, Part A program work.
