Ryan uses spray paint and other tools to create pictures that show

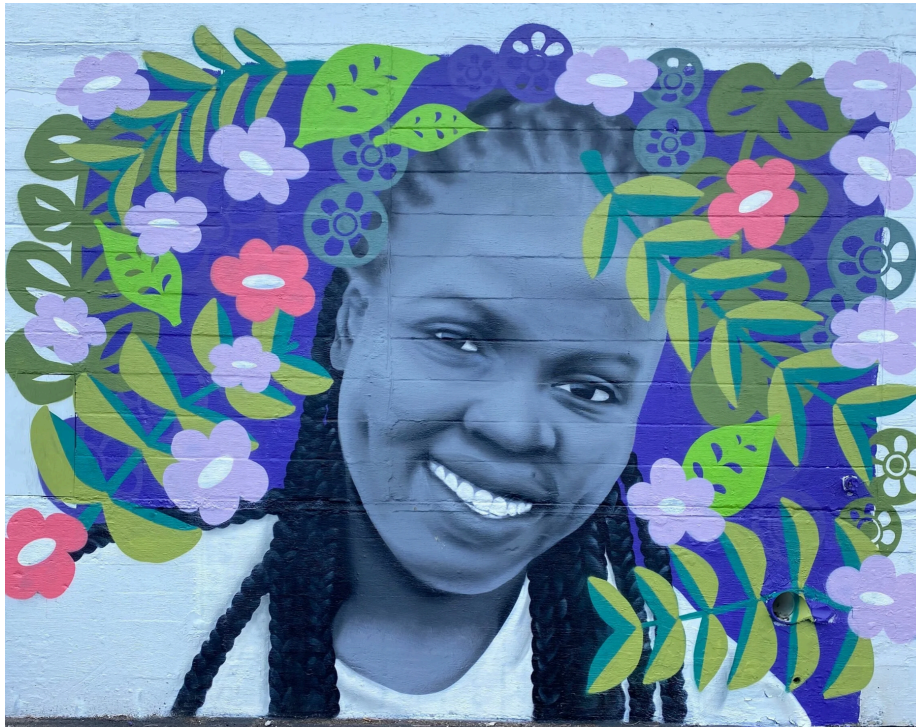
nature, feelings, and big ideas. His art isn't just in Maine; you can find his work in many cities all around the world!
