During Your Vaccination Visit

Maintain physical distancing at least 2 meters/6 feet

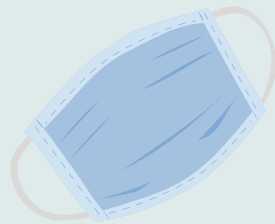


You will receive a vaccination card

- Take a picture, save it, and bring it to your appointment for your second dose



Wear your mask



You will receive a fact sheet about which vaccine you received

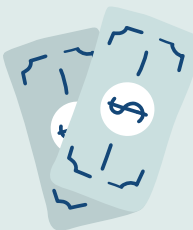


Tell your vaccine provider if you have a history of previous severe allergic reactions



The COVID-19 vaccine is free if you are uninsured

- If you have insurance (private or Medicare): Bring your insurance card



Share with other community members that you received the vaccine



You will be asked to self report race and ethnicity

- By doing so, you are ensuring vaccine equity distribution
- Data won't be used against you
