SUBJECT: Request Approval to allocate remaining FY2022 Maine Carl D. Perkins Targeted Reserve Grant funds as authorized under the Strengthening Career and Technical Education For The 21st Century Act (P. L. 115-224).

The State Board of Education's Career and Technical Education Committee recommends to the State Board of Education the remaining FY22 Perkins V targeted reserve grant funds, be allocated to Maine's eligible secondary CTE schools in accordance with section 131 of the Perkins V Act, and be added to their FY23 Perkins formula awards. Due to time constraints, these remaining funds are not able to be awarded through the targeted reserve funding process.

- FY22 Perkins V targeted reserve grant funds to be allocated is \$32,837

RECOMMENDATION: The State Board Education approve the allocation of the remaining FY22 Perkins V targeted reserve grant funds to Maine's eligible secondary CTE schools and be added to their FY23 Perkins formula awards. Total amount allocated will not exceed \$32,837.
