Please completely describe the basis for the SAU's one-year waiver request and further describe how the SAU is meeting the needs of the gifted and talented population in your district (Use as much space as necessary):

We currently offer a 30 minute per day intervention block for every student in our school. The interventions are based on student assessment data and include offerings specific to every student such as remedial math, reading strategies, and behavioral concerns. For students meeting or exceeding standards, interventions are offered which extend learning opportunities. The daily intervention block is above and beyond differentiated instruction offered in the regular classroom for our high achieving students.

The Helen S. Dunn School is a PreK through Grade 8 School with approximately 150 students. We have 10 grade level classrooms. We operate on a very limited budget and also added more Special Education teacher time this year due to increased student needs in Special Education. In addition to the required local share that taxpayers must raise, our residents raise an additional local share just to operate our school with our limited staff and resources. Any additional requirements for staffing and programs would be an extreme burden.


