CREATE OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS TO EXHBIT DISPOSITIONS.

The first step in assessing student dispositions is to give students opportunities to show them.

OBSERVATIONS

One way to look for growth of dispositions is by observing students in the situations you created. It is important that you start with a baseline. One student's growth may not look the same as another's.

INTERVIEWS

Hold conversations with students about their feelings and understanding of dispositions.

OPEN ENDED QUESTIONNAIRES

Students discuss their awareness and use of dispositions.
For instance, What helped you persist when you felt a struggle with a task?

5

SELF ASSESSMENT

After an opportunity to practice a disposition, use a scale of 1-10 and ask students to self-assess their use of and comfort with the disposition(s).
