Reminder about DAC and SAC Accounts in ADAM

- All previous user accounts were removed prior to Spring 2024, including District Assessment Coordinator (DAC) and School Assessment Coordinator (SAC) accounts.
- DACs must re-establish their account by entering their district email at <u>https://adamexam.com</u>, and then selecting "Forgot Password" to create a new password for Spring 2024
- DACs will create accounts in ADAM for their SACs and DTCs.
- SACs will create accounts in ADAM for STCs.
- Teachers and Proctors do not have individual account logins. They will use the Test Code and Proctor Code to administer assessments.

## **Embedded Universal Tools**

Embedded Universal Tools for All Students					
Tool Description					
Provisions within online assessment platform to all students automatically					
Review	Review page shows flagged items for review and items not attempted.				
Accessibility Accessibility options of Color Scheme / Font Size / Zoom enlargement (ADAM Accessibility Tools see page 7).					
Flag or BookmarkAbility to flag or bookmark an item to return to for review.					
Line Reader	The line reader tool helps focus on reading one line of text at a time.				
Response Masking	Ability to hide/cover an answer choice – not available on all item types such as technology enhanced.				





## **Non-Embedded Universal Tools**

Non-Embedded Universal Tools for All Students					
Tool Description					
Provisions provided by the proctor to all students					
Scrap/Scratch Paper	The student uses scratch paper, an individual erasable whiteboard, or an assistive technology device to make notes or record responses. Scratch paper can be lined, blank, or graph. All scratch paper must be collected and securely destroyed at the end of each test to maintain test security.				







## **Designated Supports**

Utilization and implementation of designated supports are determined on an individual basis

by a team of two or more education professionals with knowledge of a student's performance, and
 supports must be consistent with the student's normal routine during classroom instruction and assessment.

Provision of supports does not alter the construct of any test item.





## **Embedded Designated Support**

Tool Description					
Provisions	Provisions provided within the platform that must be assigned to an individual student				
	Text is read aloud to the student via (embedded) TTS technology. TTS should be consistent				
Text-to-Speech (TTS)	with the student's normal routine during classroom instruction. Headphones/earbuds are				
	necessary unless tested individually in a separate setting.				





## **Text-to-Speech Supplemental Guidance**

All students with text-to-speech or read aloud as an accommodation in an IEP, 504 plan, or ILAP **MUST** be assigned TTS for the online assessment.

For all other students, TTS is an approved designated support for students who are offered the opportunity to access text-to-speech and/or read aloud as part of their normal routine during classroom instruction and assessment.

If educators perceive that a student would struggle to <u>decode</u> two or more words from their grade-level list, text-to-speech is an appropriate designated support for that student.

To be enabled, TTS must be assigned to the student within the assessment platform.

Extended Time	Students with extended time must complete the assessment session on the day it was started;

Small Craun or	This designated support is used to minimize distractions for students whose test is

## **Nonembedded Supports**

Examples of supports that can be provided to students and do <u>**not**</u> need to be indicated in the assessment platform include the following:

- Assistive technology
- Medical devices
- Visual aids (e.g., magnification devices, external monitors, reduction of visual print by blocking or other techniques, student privacy shields)
- Auditory devices (e.g., special acoustics, amplification, noise buffers, whisper phones, calming music)
- Student reads assessment aloud to self in individual setting
- Directions clarification





## Accommodations

Non-Embedded Accommodations					
Tool Description					
Provisions Outside of the Platform Based on IEP or 504 Plan					
American Sign Language Text is translated via sign language interpreter to student by Test Administrator as documented in IEP/504 plan.					
Scribe	The student may dictate answers to a human scribe in an individual setting as indicated by a student's IEP/504 plan. Human scribe records verbatim what a student dictates and must give the student an opportunity to review scribed text. Scribed answers must be entered into the online testing platform - no paper submissions accepted.

## Proctoring Roles

## **Teachers and other Proctors**

- Access the proctor dashboard with a test code and proctor code unique to each proctor group per session
- View and manage only the students in that specific proctor group and session
- Have authority to pause, resume, and reseat student test sessions
- Can not create or manage proctor groups

## District Assessment Coordinators and School Assessment Coordinators

- Access the proctor dashboard through the test admin cards when logged in to ADAM
- View and manage multiple proctor groups in their school or district
- Have authority to pause, resume, and reseat student test sessions
- Create and manage proctor groups



Creating and Managing Proctor Groups

- Default proctor groups are created based on class information entered by the SAU
- Additional proctor groups can be created by DACs and SACs for test administration convenience
- Students in additional proctor groups are still associated with their original class rosters and reports
- Common reasons for setting up additional proctor groups include: accommodations (e.g., extended time group), testing location (e.g., library group), make up group of students who were absent, other
- Default proctor groups can be modified through the class dashboard. Additional proctor groups can be modified through the proctor group details page

## **Reseating Students**

## **Scenarios:**

- Time-out / Idle for too long
- Network disruption
- Student accidentally closed the test window
- System closed the test due to detection of unallowed program attempting to run at the same time



## **Reseating Students**

## Scenarios:

 If reseating still doesn't allow the student to continue their test, it may have already been submitted. Unsubmitting / reopening a test requires MDOE approval.



## Warning messages when launching the Lockdown Browser

- Not connected to the Internet
- Slow network
- Other applications running in background
- Not enough battery power
- Too many monitors
- Insufficient memory
- Low resolution display
- Microsoft Edge issues



#### **System Startup Checks**

The ADAM Lockdown Browser automatically verifies the following system requirements. If a device fails one of these checks, a summary of the issue is displayed on the screen, and when possible, the user will have an opportunity to resolve it. For example, if the lockdown browser detects that a device has two monitors, an alert will provide instructions with an option for the user to unplug one monitor and then select "Retry" to rerun the checks. Similar notifications are provided if the device has a low battery level or is not plugged into a power outlet.

Warning messages about hard drive space, screen resolution, and battery/power status may display when ADAM starts but do not prevent students from running the assessment.

- The student device must have access to the internet before the lockdown browser will initialize for student use.
- After the operating system check is complete, a final network check is needed based on how long it takes for the first page of the lockdown browser to load. If the initial page load exceeds the limit set, the system check will fail.

#### **Microsoft Edge on Windows-Based Devices**

For Windows-based devices, it is recommended that prior to starting the assessment, school IT administrators disable the system setting that allows the Edge browser to "continue running background extensions and apps when Microsoft Edge is closed".

- 1. Ensure the device is running the latest version of Edge
- 2. Go to ... -> Settings -> System and performance
  - Disable "Startup boost"
  - Disable "Continue running background extensions and apps when Microsoft Edge is closed"



## Warning messages when launching the test

- Student not found
  - Re-enter SSID
  - Check student roster
- Test not found
  - Re-enter test code
  - Check code on test ticket
- Test is already in session
  - Reseat the student
- Test is blocked (paper-only students)
  - Administer the student's assigned paper test
- Session is already submitted
  - Student completed the test
  - Student accidentally submitted the test and needs to be unsubmitted (requires MDOE approval)
  - Student started but did not complete the test and was autosubmitted at end of day (requires MDOE approval to reopen test on a subsequent day)
