

Web-Based Meal Benefit Application

Maine DOE has extended their partnership with Nutri-Link Technologies, Inc, to provide an online meal benefit application through

Traditional Application Process

- Collect and process applications
 - ▶ 30 school day carry over of benefits applies from prior year.
- Process Applications within 10 days of receipt
- Send notices home to families of eligibility determination
- Complete the Verification process, normal
- Complete October survey, normal
- Complete monthly claim for reimbursement based on each student's eligibility determination

Sponsor Information Sheet Verification

- Normal Verification procedures are followed.
- ► When completing the Annual Participation Agreement in CNPweb, for Type of Verification, Select "Basic"

Type of Verification

Verification is required for all SFAs participating in the National School Lunch Program.

- - Complete the Error Prone Process

October Survey

Completed normally.

Based on number of approved applications as of October 31st.


▶ Submitted in CNPweb.

Pricing Programs

- ► The State of Maine is paying the difference between the Federal reimbursement of free meals to reduced and paid meals, both breakfast and lunch.
- Students are not charged for reimbursable meals
- School District will do regular claiming based on the number of students that took the meal and their eligibility status.


