We wanted to reach out with a few updates from the Rethinking Remote Education Ventures (RREV) team. We are thrilled to announce that our first class of Innovative Educators are wrapping up their pilot designs. These pilots capture the **innovation, creativity and empathy** which lies at the heart of the RREV mission.

Rethinking Remote Education Ventures is designed to foster innovative mindsets, creativity, and the deep empathy that is endemic to all educators. RREV is a catalyst for educators to develop the tools to design pilots which initiate systems-level change in their districts and communities. Teachers, support staff and administrators are encouraged to enroll in one of our Innovative Mindset and Pilot Design (IMPD) Classes, in teams with colleagues from the same district. Individuals are also welcome, but a team of at least one administrator and one teacher are required to apply for pilot funding. There is no charge to participate in these innovation courses. Participants will have the option to choose courses where they can earn 3 graduate level credits or micro-credentials in innovative design.
