Middle School CTE (MS-CTE) Experiences

- <u>CTE camp experience</u> Summer or vacation camp offered multiple days during non-school hours for a minimum 20 of hours which includes at least 3 CTE program opportunities.
- <u>CTE during school camp experience</u> Camp experience offered during school hours in conjunction with the secondary CTE programming offered for multiple days for a minimum of 20 hours which includes at least 3 CTE program opportunities– may utilize CTE students for delivering instruction, middle school and secondary students attend together.
- <u>Traveling CTE experience</u> CTE teacher/CTE coordinator goes to the middle schools (in catchment area) offering CTE programming students would experience CTE on a rotating basis (at least 4 encounters) with other middle schools in catchment area. Lab may be mobile or stationary at the middle school.
- <u>MS CTE offered at the CTE school</u> Students attend the CTE school for an extended timeframe four weeks to full year (usually a full quarter or more) during normal school hours. The experience will include at least one full period. Students rotate through several programs.
- <u>CTE instruction offered at the middle school</u> instruction is taught during one section of the school day for an extended timeframe four weeks to full year and students cycle through CTE either by a selection or a requirement. The experience will include at least one full period. The instruction may be offered by CTE or middle school staff.
- <u>CTE after school program</u> MS students attend the CTE school after regular school hours, students may rotate through more than one program experience must last multiple weeks: at least 1 time per week. Minimum hours 20 per experience.
- <u>Mentorship with staff students and industry</u>- students attend programs for multiple day exposure and in select program for mentorship. Mentorship may be with secondary student, teacher, or business. 20 hours minimum
