Establishing or Expanding a Public Pre-K Program

If your district is interested in opening a new, or expanding a current, public preschool program, please refer to the following steps.

- 1. To receive funding on your ED 279 for Pre-K students for the year in which you are starting or expanding programming, SAUs must complete the Estimate Pre-K Count Data From the fall preceding the school year in which the program will begin.
 - 1. The Fall 2021 form will be due no later than November 5, 2021 to reflect school year 2022-2023 estimated Pre-K enrollment counts.
 - 2. The form link is provided in the <u>Maine DOE News</u> in October of each year. The link to this year's form is <u>available here</u>.
- 2. Become familiar with <u>Chapter 124: Basic Approval Standards: Public Preschool Programs</u>.
- Complete Maine DOE's public pre-k application by using the <u>on-line application</u> and submit it by April 30, 2022 for a fall 2022 opening date. Applications will be reviewed and districts will be notified of approval from Maine DOE. Users can access a PDF version of the application <u>here</u>.

Currently there is a <u>Request for Applications (RFA)</u> available to SAUs to apply for grant funding to support establishment or expansion of Pre-K programming in school year 2022-2023. Those interested should complete the application no later than November 4, 2021.
