COVID-19 Timeline/History

The State of Maine CDC is currently responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, which was caused by a novel (new) coronavirus. The Maine CDC initially started monitoring this outbreak in December 2019. On March 2, 2020, Governor Mills initiated a Coronavirus Response Team. This was headed by Maine CDC Director, Dr. Nirav Shah, with commissioners from various other states agencies. The state of Maine reported its first positive presumptive case of COVID-19 on March 12, 2020. This was followed by Gov. Mills declaring a Civil State of Emergency on March 15, 2020. The recommendations included ceasing all public school in-person classroom instruction, as well as various other measures sought to slow the spread of the virus.

The Mills administration, by utilizing both state resources, and federal assistance, effectively launched multiple testing sites for COVID-19. Gov. Mills and her administration also compiled a series of steps to assist and support school systems across Maine for whether they should, and also how to return to in-classroom instruction for fall 2020. With accessibility to testing, the tireless efforts of school nurses, as well as the D.O.E. providing support and guidance, Maine schools were able to provide in-person classroom instruction.

The state of Maine has done well with getting those that are eligible vaccinated. As of May 10, 2021, the Pfizer vaccine was given approval to be administered to children aged 12 years and older. On June 9, 2021, the Mills administration informed all Maine School Administrative Units (SAUs) that it expects all schools to provide full-time, in-person learning for the fall of 2021.
