Overview:

Coyote Online Opportunity (Co-Op) is a pathway for students to receive a quality education in a setting that best works for each student. Students in grades 6-12 may be referred by self, family, or staff to be served through this remote/hybrid program. A team works with the student/family to identify if this service is the best fit for the student's needs. Those students served by the program receive challenging and engaging instruction through a combination of:

- Participating in the regular instructional program to the extent possible
- Some direct remote instruction from our multi-age teacher leader
- Case management support from that teacher leader while accessing other remote instruction

Students that are part of this program will not only have access to remote instruction but will have access to all the other programming and co-curricular opportunities that RSU 34 has to offer.

Through this opportunity, we will provide another layer of support for students with atypical needs and interests, leading to greater success in schooling for those individuals while tied directly in to the mission, values, expectations, and network of our middle and high schools.

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
