Dear Superintendent Johnson:

The RSU 85/MSAD 19 Nutrition Program was reviewed on December 11, 2019 per Federal Regulation 7CFR 210.18 and Maine Department of Education Child Nutrition policies and procedures.

The enclosed Official Notification of Review Findings and Corrective Action describes the corrective action documentation required. Please submit a detailed response for each of the review findings listed in the report. Responses must be submitted through CNPweb, Maine Department of Education Child Nutrition's Administrative Review software, and must address the following:

- How the finding was corrected (include who, when & how)
- Documentation that the finding has been corrected district-wide
- How this action will ensure future compliance

In accordance with §210.18(k), failure to return completed documentation within 30 days from the corrective action deadline date will result in the withholding of reimbursement payments. We hope that following the exit conference you and your staff addressed the corrective actions and that you will have no problems in meeting the response deadline.

The Official Notification also provides the potential fiscal action, which is an initial estimate of the amount of reimbursement that will be reclaimed. These are only estimates which must be adjusted to the actual date of corrective action for each violation. If documentation of corrective action or acceptable corrective action is not received by the response date stated above, the claim will be recalculated to the end of the school year.

Technical Assistance

- * Menu signage describing to student's what meal components to take in order to receive a reimbursable meal was not posted as required. TA was given and menu signage was provided and posted while the reviewer was on site.
- * The current meal charging procedure states that an alternate meal will be provided to students who have a debt to their school nutrition account. The State of Maine has passed a law stating this practice can no longer be used. Each student must be offered the full reimbursable meal that is offered. The current charging policy must be updated to reflect this.
