An Administrative Review of the RSU 86/MSAD 20 Nutrition Program was conducted on October 30, 2019.

The enclosed Official Notification of Administrative Review Findings and Corrective Action describes the corrective action documentation and completion dates discussed during the exit conference. The Official Notification also provides the potential fiscal action, which is an initial estimate of the amount of reimbursement that will be reclaimed. If documentation of corrective action or acceptable corrective action is not received by the response date stated above, the claim must be recalculated to the end of the school year.

* Staff does a very good job in the preparing and serving of meals to students. The kitchen is kept clean, the food is safe. Staff interacts with their customers very well. Students enjoy coming to the cafeteria.

Technical Assistance

- * During a stop at Fort Fairfield Middle/High School it was observed the two liquid vending machines in the cafeteria had items that are not allowed to be sold to Middle school students based on the Smart Snacks rule. Information was given to the Food Service Director to correct this.
- * RSU 86 is in the Grace Year of Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) at Fort Fairfield Elementary School. If on April 1, 2020 the percentage of enrolled students in Fort Fairfield Elementary school are Directly Certified a new four-year cycle for CEP can be implanted. If not Fort Fairfield Elementary School will either need to return to collecting applications every year or consider Special Provision II.
