Dear Superintendent Boles:

The Ellsworth Public Schools Nutrition Program was reviewed on November 1, 2022 per Federal Regulation 7CFR 210.18 and Maine Department of Education Child Nutrition policies and procedures.

The enclosed Official Notification of Review Findings and Corrective Action describes the corrective action documentation required. Please submit a detailed response for each of the review findings listed in the report. Responses must be submitted through CNPweb, Maine Department of Education Child Nutrition's Administrative Review software, and must address the following:

- How the finding was corrected (include who, when & how)
- Documentation that the finding has been corrected district-wide
- How this action will ensure future compliance

In accordance with §210.18(k), failure to return completed documentation within 30 days from the corrective action deadline date will result in the withholding of reimbursement payments. We hope that following the exit conference you and your staff addressed the corrective actions and that you will have no problems in meeting the response deadline.

The Official Notification also provides the potential fiscal action, which is an initial estimate of the amount of reimbursement that will be reclaimed. These are only estimates which must be adjusted to the actual date of corrective action for each violation. If documentation of corrective action or acceptable corrective action is not received by the response date stated above, the claim will be recalculated to the end of the school year.

Finding 9000: Application Approval Error

One meal benefit application was approved for reduced benefits incorrectly.

Corrective Action:

Finding 9000: Meals Counted for Reimbursement Prior to Being Served to Students

At breakfast service, a teacher was observed taking three meals for students and these meals were claimed for reimbursement without the students being present. Meals may only be claimed for reimbursement at the point when the student has received a reimbursable meal. The three meals are not eligible for reimbursement and were re-claimed as part of the claim revision with finding 126 Certification & Benefit Issuance.

Corrective Action:

Develop and implement an allowable meal counting and claiming procedure for claiming meals for students who are not able to come to the cafeteria to select their own meal. Describe this procedure on the Maine DOE Child Nutrition 'Alternate Service Location' form and submit via CNPweb.

Meal Components & Quantities - Ellsworth Elementary-Middle School (1463)

409. Review period production records/documentation - required meal components offered, daily/weekly requirements met? Enter data.

Finding 9000: Production Records Indicate Insufficient Serving Size of Vegetable

Production records for lunch indicated a 1/2 cup vegetable serving size. After discussion, students can have as much as they want. Technical assistance was provided that the required serving size of vegetables for grades K-8 is 3/4 cup and with offer versus serve the minimum a student has to take is 1/2 cup.

Corrective Action:

Staff revised their production record to reflect the 3/4 cup serving size prior to the onsite review. No further corrective action is necessary.
