



Understanding how to read a medication label is very important to student health and safety. Reading the label carefully, slowly, and deliberately will help prevent errors. In the label below, teach to find the RIGHT student, RIGHT medication, RIGHT dose, RIGHT route, and RIGHT time. Consider using a highlighter to assist in teaching and giving the copy to your UAP. Documentation is the 6th RIGHT (State of Maine Department of Education and State Board of Education, 2022; National Association of School Nurses, 2021).
