During the spring of 2017, a K-8 parent survey was distributed to parents for the purpose of receiving feedback on access to, impact of, and satisfaction with Gifted And Talented services. Approximately ½ of eligible parents responded to the survey. 70% of responses showed satisfaction with the level of collaboration with families to meet the learning needs of students. Numerous comments identify high satisfaction with their child's Gifted and Talented teachers, the relationships they build with students, and the services they provide. 84% of parents that responded indicated that there was adequate support to meet their child's learning needs. Parents reported that student satisfaction with academic enrichment opportunities was high, particularly in Robotics, MathCount Competition, and Math Team. A concern regarding the frequency of reporting after the initial development of the individualized learning plan was raised by several parents. This will be reviewed during the 2017-2018 school year.
