USDA Food program

- The USDA program began during the Great Depression in the early 1930's.
- There was massive unemployment and hunger.
- Farms suffered from surpluses because people had no money to buy their goods.
- As a result, crops and livestock ended up having to be destroyed because no one could afford to buy them.
- In 1933, the first of many laws was established by Congress with creation of the Federal Surplus Commodities Corporation, later to be called the Commodity Credit Corporation-(CCC).
- This created loans for farms and price support for excess crops and livestock. Because times were financially very difficult, the government allowed for loan payments to be in the form of crops.
- These crops were donated to newly created domestic and international outlets, including the National School Lunch program-(NSLP)




Once added to FFAVORS, an email notification to the user with step by step instructions on how to create the Login.gov account will be generated. Without the profile in FFAVORS, the user will not gain access to the application. For those that currently have an eAuthentication ID, the user profile must still be created in FFAVORS before accessing the site. You may continue to use an existing eAuthentication ID at this time or create your Login.gov ID to use with FFAVORS.


Net Off Invoice (NOI)
