# Overview -Audience

  - Schools exploring Title I Schoolwide Authority but still operating a Targeted Assistance Program
- \*Not TA for Schoolwide plan/CNA development

# Purpose of Schoolwide Authority:

## ESSA-Section 1114

To raise the achievement of the lowest-achieving students by improving the entire school program:

- 1) Schools can consolidate federal, state, and local funds to better meet the needs of students in the school
- 2) No identification requirement; Students don't have to be "eligible" to participate in school programs
- 3) Develop and Implement Multi-Tiered Systems of Support \*(MTSS)- programs and supports that are relevant to all students and individualized to support the most "at-risk" students
- 4) Maximize resources and address the unique academic and non-academic needs in a school

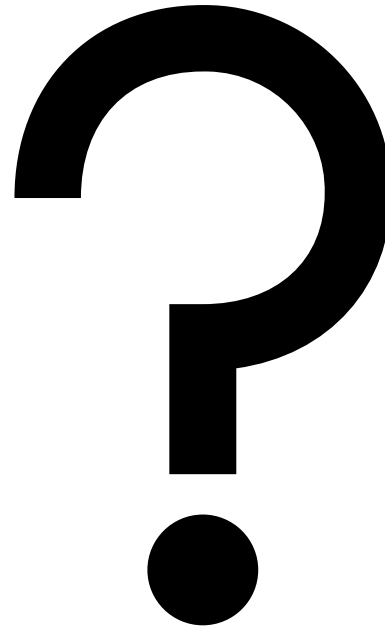
# Considerations
