

## Using the FNS Mapper for “Census Maybes”

1. Enter a provider’s address. The resulting screen is shown in the figure titled figure 1.



2. If the map is blue, click on the “- symbol” in the upper left corner until you can see if there are any pink block groups (BGs) near a provider’s BG. In the figure titled figure 2, I clicked the “- symbol” 4 times to ensure that I could see all surrounding BGs; the number of clicks will vary, just be sure that you have zeroed in sufficiently to see the surrounding BGs.



Now click on the “> symbol” inside the dark blue search result rectangle. If the search result shows (1 of 1), click on the “x inside a circle symbol” to close that search result rectangle and then click on the black dot to open a search result rectangle that shows search result (1 of 2). The first screen will show the provider’s address and the second screen will show the provider’s BG information.

3. If the percentage of children (0-18) eligible for F/RP meals and/or the percentage of children (0-12) eligible for F/RP meals is 40% or greater, this is a “census maybe”. The figure titled figure 3 shows that the percentage of children (0-18) eligible for F/RP meals is 46.2% for this BG.

4. Exit the screen shown in figure 3 by using the “downward facing arrow inside of a circle symbol” that is located in the upper right corner. This will take you back to the map and you will now see the provider’s BG surrounded by a border that is neon blue in color, as shown in figure 4.



Figure 4 shows that there are 4 BGs that are pink in color adjacent to the provider’s BG (3 of these BGs are clearly evident and the 4<sup>th</sup> is defined by a dotted line inside the largest pink area at the bottom of figure 4). To be considered adjacent, the BGs must be touching.

DCH Sponsors should e-mail the name and physical address of providers with results such as the one outlined above to the SA as a census maybe. The SA will calculate the weighted average and will notify the sponsor by e-mail of the results of the weighted average calculation.
