## **Major Capital School Construction**

The five-member team has completed the required 75 site visits for applications submitted in the Spring of 2017. Analysis of information collected during those site visits and calibration of scores will take place over the next several months. Once that process is complete a Proposed Priority List will be recommended by the Commissioner to the State Board of Education for consideration.

# 2017 – 2018 Integrated, Consolidated 9 - 16 Educational Facility

Three Part 2 applications for this regional school construction program were submitted by the December 29, 2017 deadline. These applications will be scored during the month of January and will result in a Proposed Priority List that the Commissioner will recommend to the State Board of Education for consideration.

# Facilities

Roofs. Be alert to the danger posed by heavy snow loads on roofs and recognize warning signs of potential structural weaknesses. Plan to remove snow from roofs before damage occurs.
