This is separate than the CLP Apprentice written and skills testing, which is arranged by school and generates a report provided to the CTE director. Possible stackable credentials include: OSHA 30, Fire Extinguisher training, Wild Fire Prevention Training (US Forest Service), GPS, GIS, National Tractor Safety Certification, CPR/First Aid, S/P2 Safety and Pollution Prevention Training, CDL, Maine Arborist License
