

Middle School CTE (MS-CTE) Experiences

- **CTE camp experience** – Summer or vacation camp offered 5 days or more during non-school hours for a minimum of 30 hours which includes 5 CTE program opportunities.
- **CTE during school camp experience** – Camp experience offered during school hours in conjunction with the secondary CTE programming offered for five days or more for a minimum of 30 hours which includes 5 CTE program opportunities– may utilize CTE students for delivering instruction, middle school and secondary students attend together.
- **Traveling CTE experience** – CTE teacher/CTE coordinator goes to the middle schools (in catchment area) offering CTE programming – students would experience CTE on a rotating basis (at least 6 encounters) with other middle schools in catchment area. Lab may be mobile or stationary at the middle school.
- **MS CTE offered at the CTE school** – Students attend the CTE school for an extended timeframe – two weeks to full year – during normal school hours. Usually one period. Students rotate through several programs.
- **CTE instruction offered at the middle school** – instruction is taught during one section of the school day and students cycle through CTE either by a selection or a requirement – usually a full quarter. The instruction may be offered by CTE or middle school staff.
- **CTE after school program** – MS students attend the CTE school after the middle school has adjourned or shortly before – students may rotate through more than one program – experience lasts multiple weeks: 1-2 times per week
- **Mentorship with staff students and industry-** students attend programs for multiple day exposure and in select program for mentorship. Mentorship may be with secondary student, teacher, or business.
