REAR ELEVATION ABUT. #1.

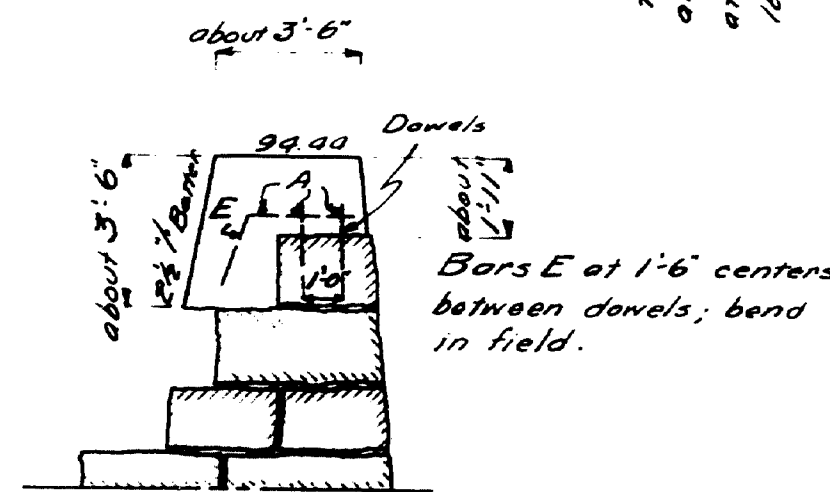


U.S. END ELEVATION.

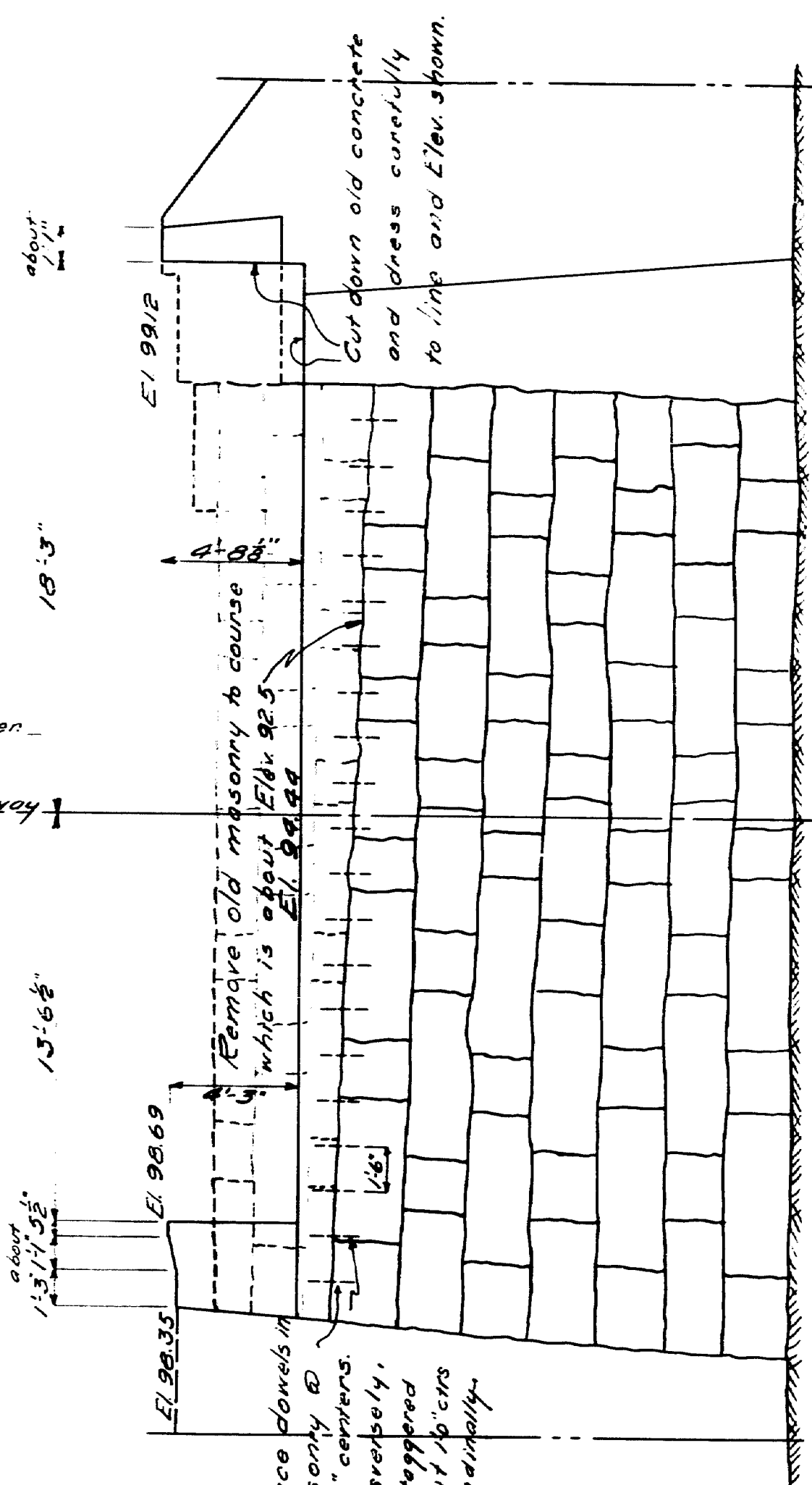


PLAN ABUT. #1.

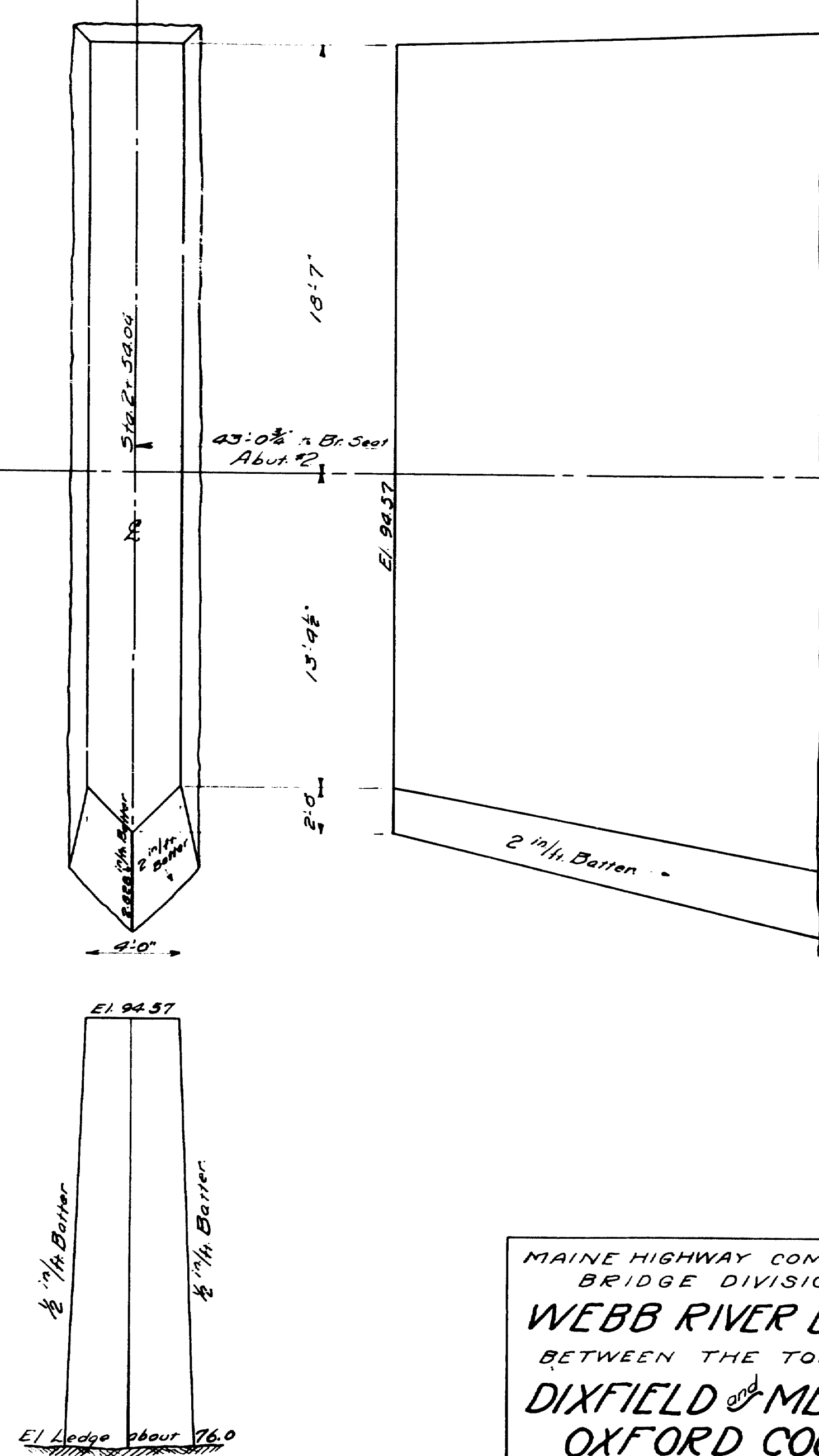

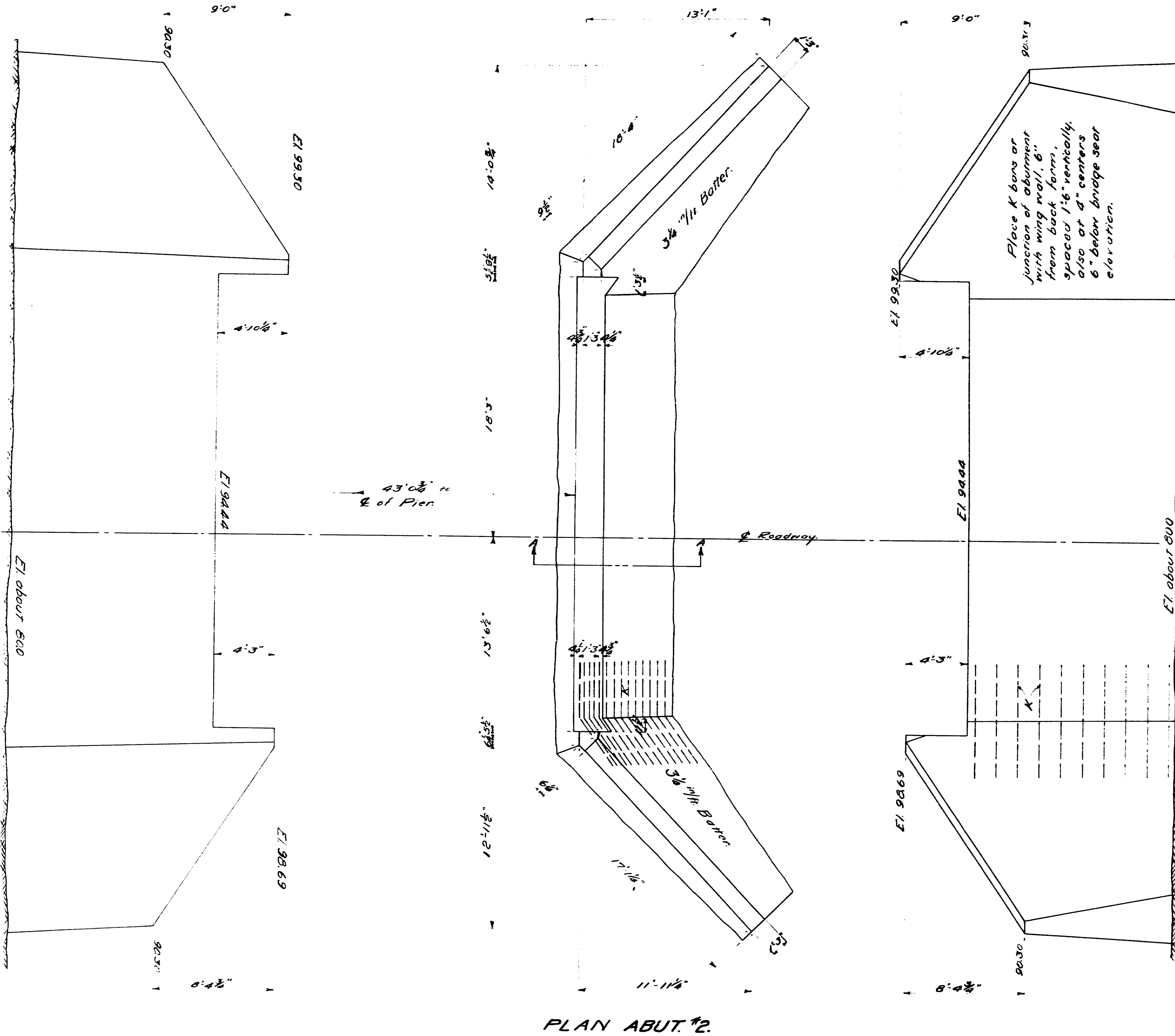
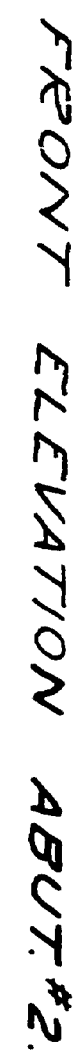
PLAN OF PIER.



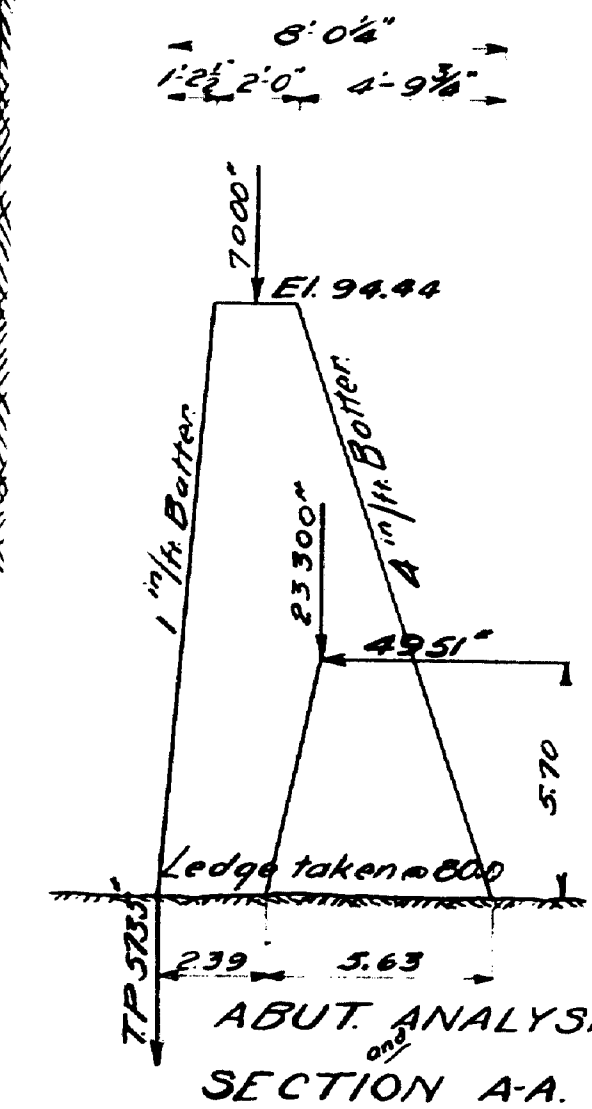
SIDE ELEVATION of PIER.

PLAN ABUT. #2.



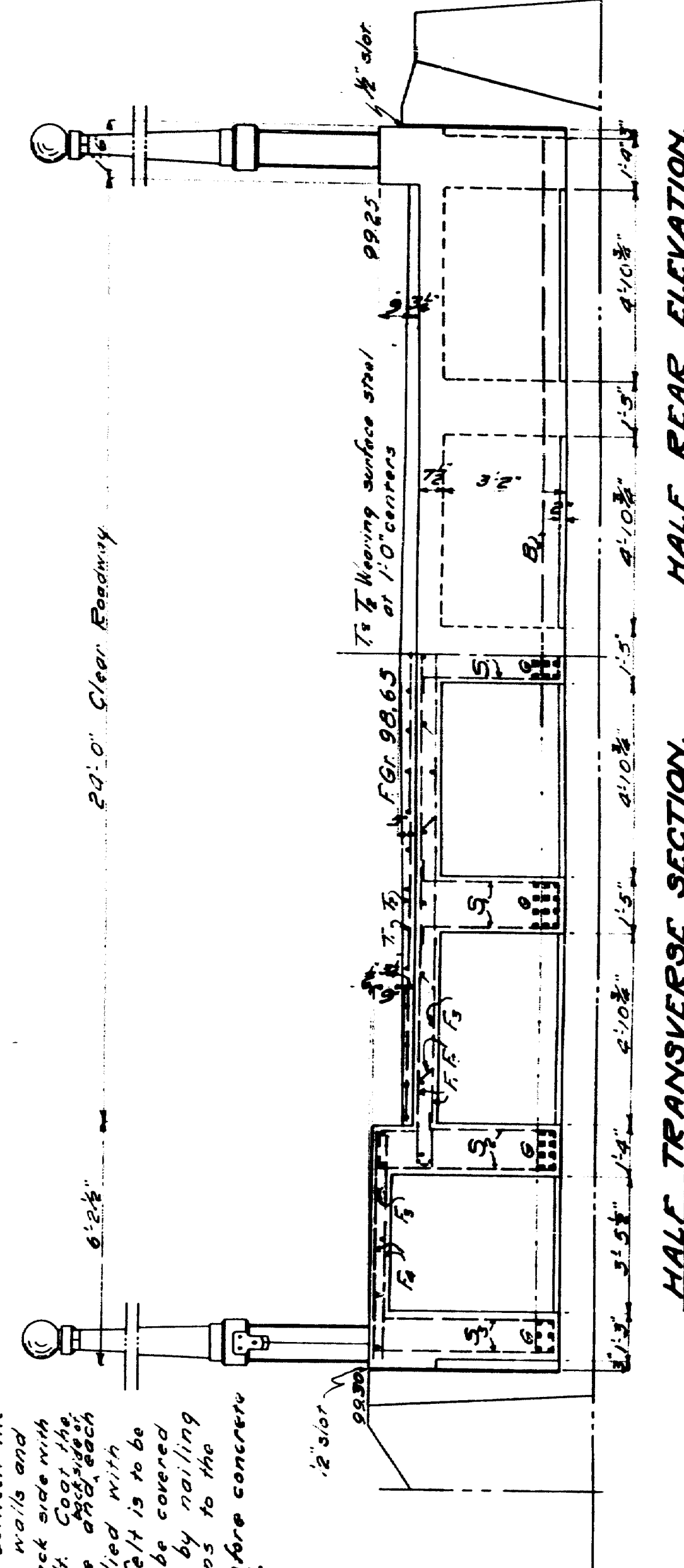
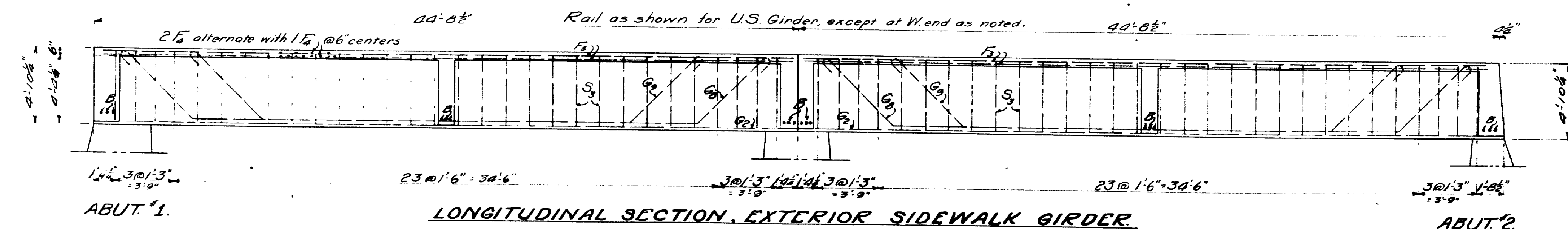
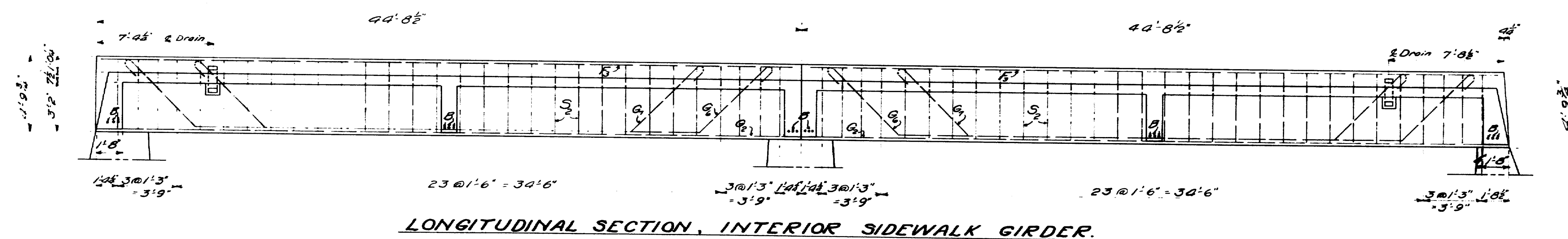
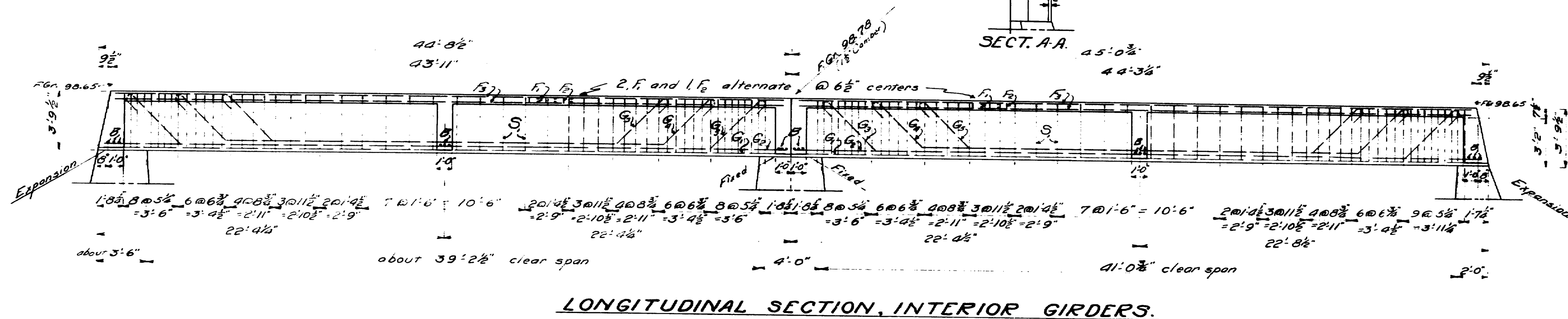
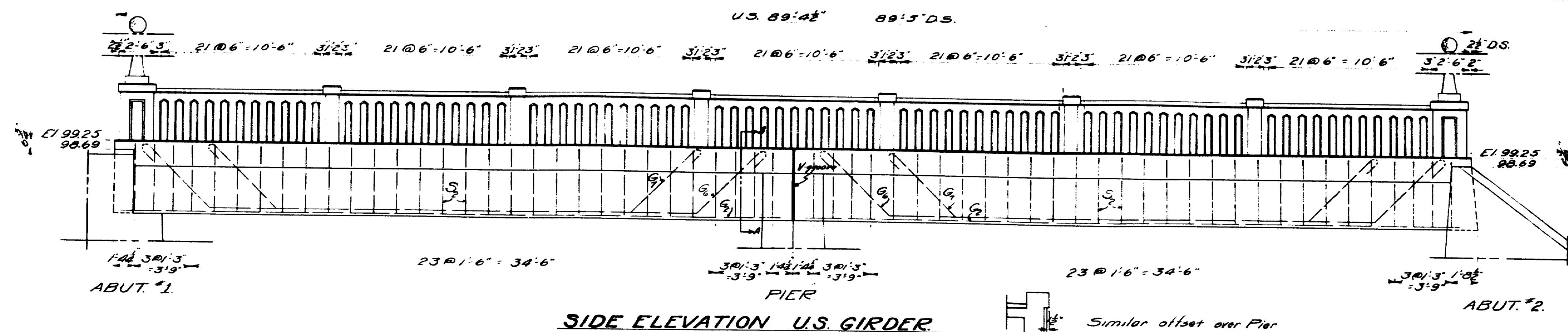

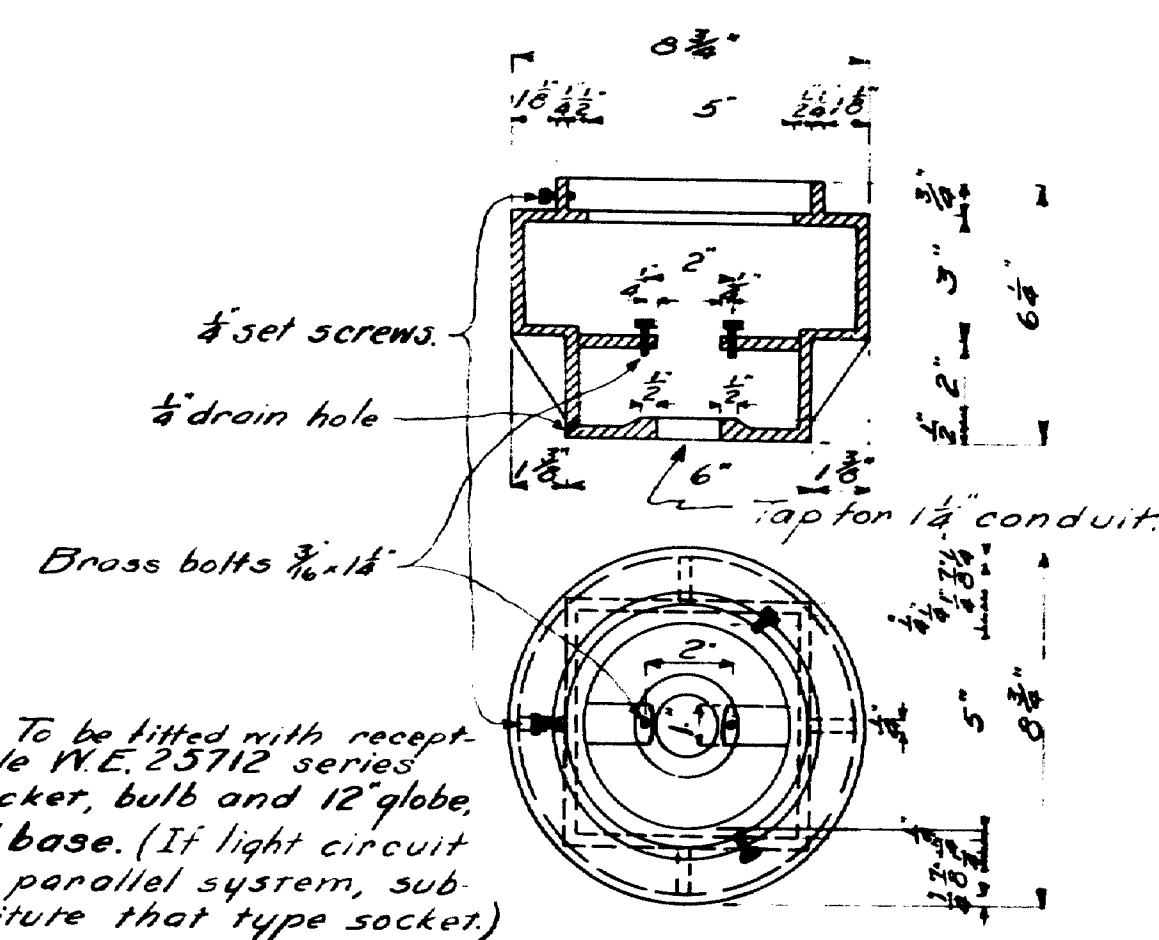
Note:— Cover the $\frac{1}{2}$ " slot between the superstructure and wing walls and the 2" opening on the back side with 2 layers of jacking felt. Coat the surface of the concrete and each layer of felt as applied with hot tar or asphalt. Felt is to be 10" wide. The area to be covered is to be recessed $\frac{1}{4}$ " by nailing thin strips to the forms, before concrete is placed.

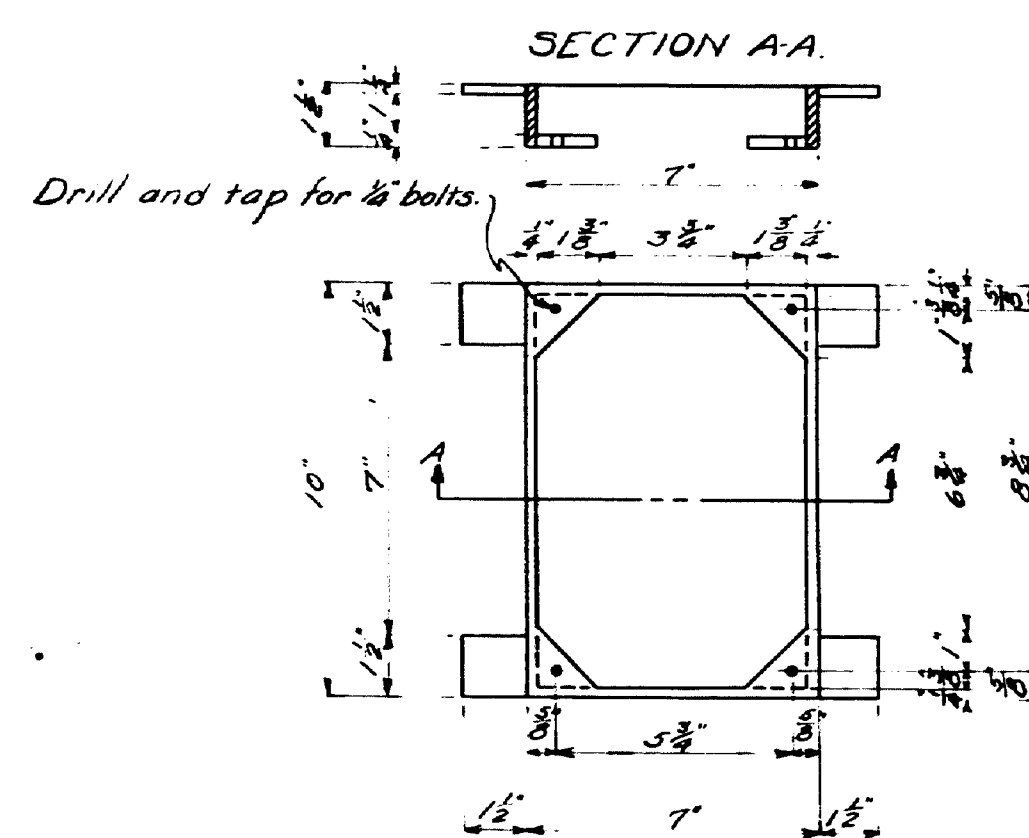


RAIL & LIGHT POST DETAIL.

PANEL DETAIL ON LIGHT POST.



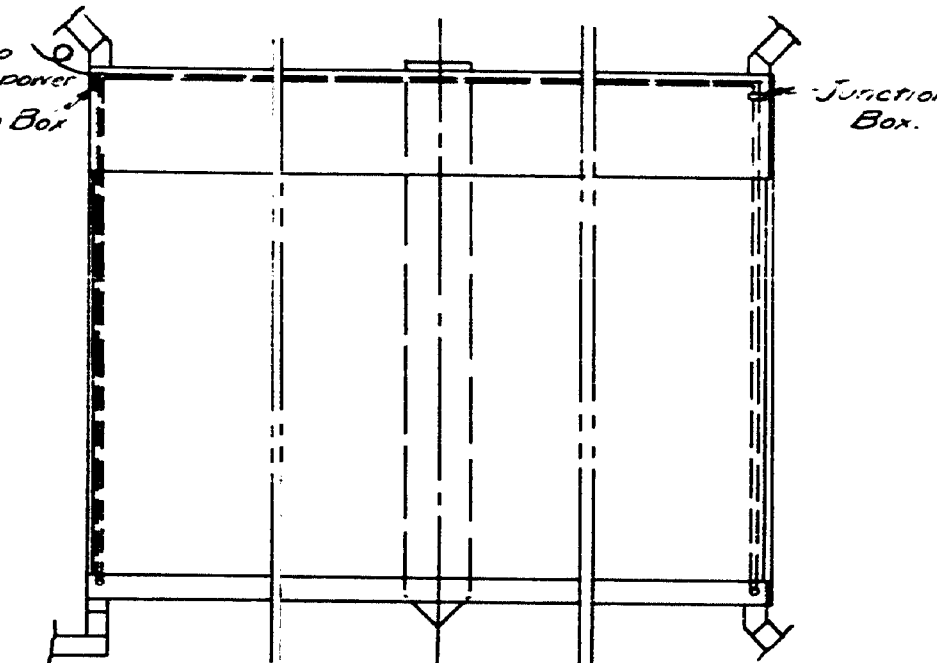

2 Zinc junction box castings; 2 Zinc covers; 8 brass bolts 1/4" x 1/2"
Note: Junction box and light post castings will be supplied by the Commission.

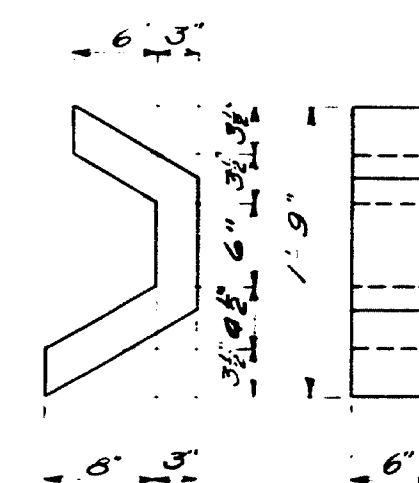
Note:— Sidewalk and curb to be cast with exterior girders above construction joint. Place steel plate posts and for rail in curb and sidewalk. At points C and D, between each opening, break bond in concrete by placing there one layer of roofing felt, cut to fit the forms, and slipped down over the reinforcing rods when concrete reaches these points. After end forms have been removed, wrap the end of each rail 6" with 2 layers of roofing felt, fold in ends and build post forms so that the rails extend into forms 1 1/2". When post forms are removed, cut away all exposed felt. All roofing felt to be 2 ply. All edges of concrete to be chamfered 1/2 in. unless otherwise indicated.



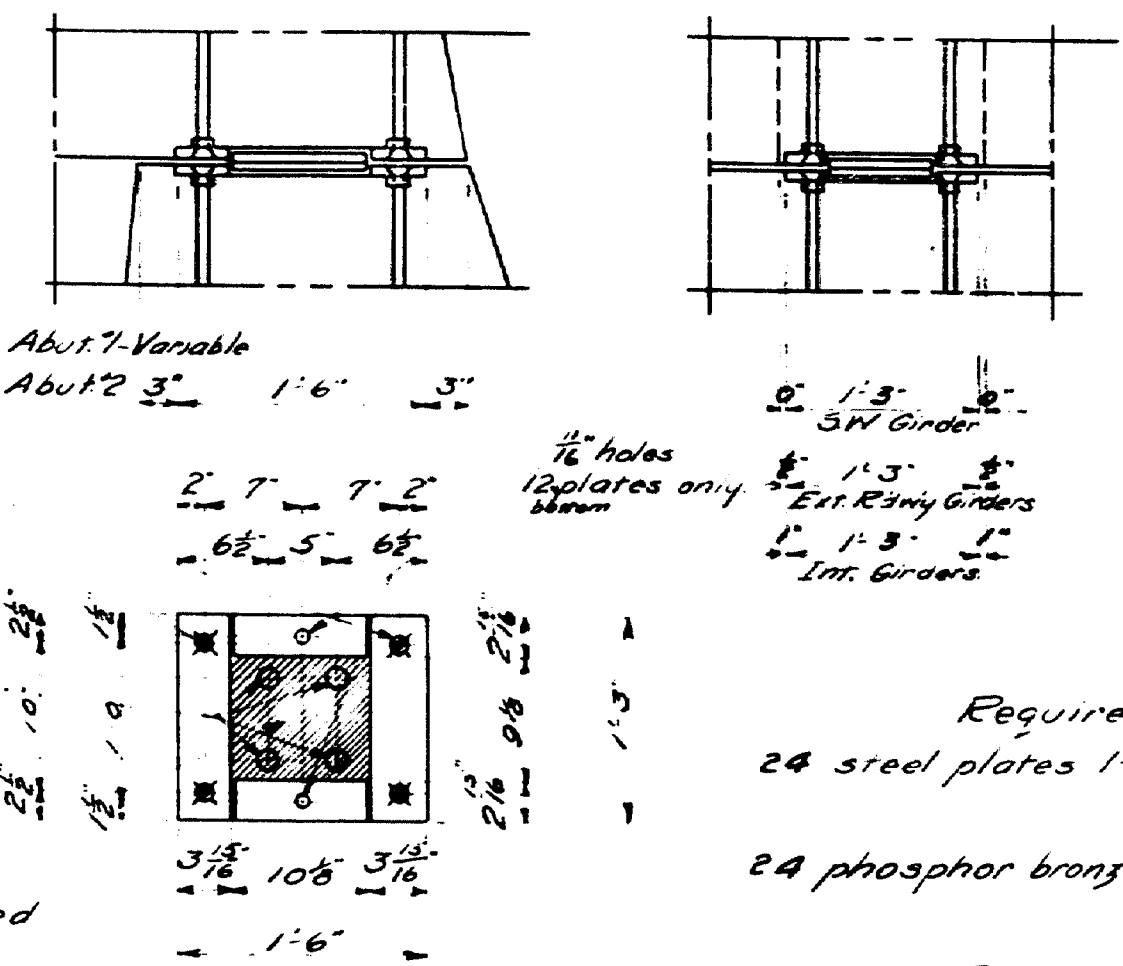
PLAN OF CONDUIT LAYOUT.

SECTION A-A.

Note:— Bends in conduit pipe shall be made by filling the pipe with sand and compact the sand by tapping the pipe; heat the pipe and bend while hot. Sand must be thoroughly dry before using. All burrs on pipe shall be removed by reaming or filing. All conduit pipe is to be 1 1/2".

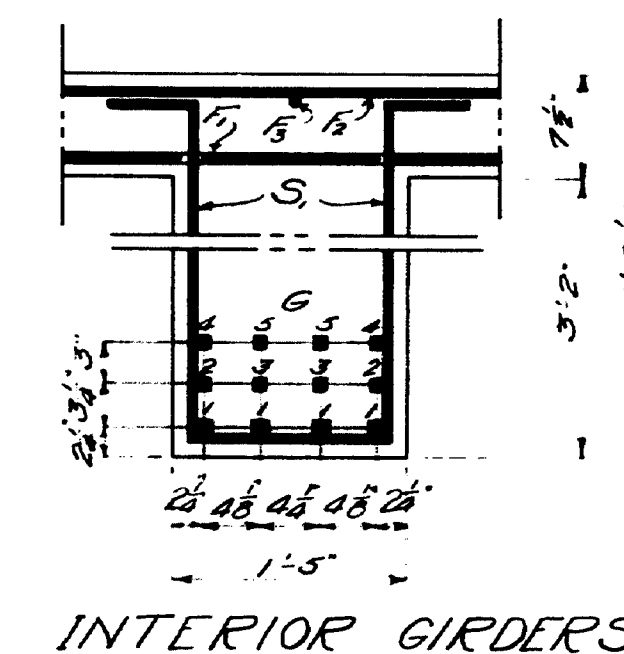

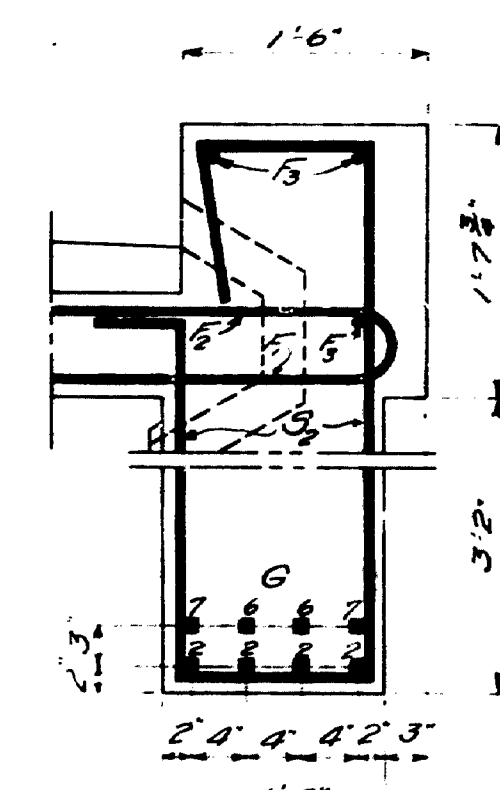


EXPANSION BEARING DETAILS.

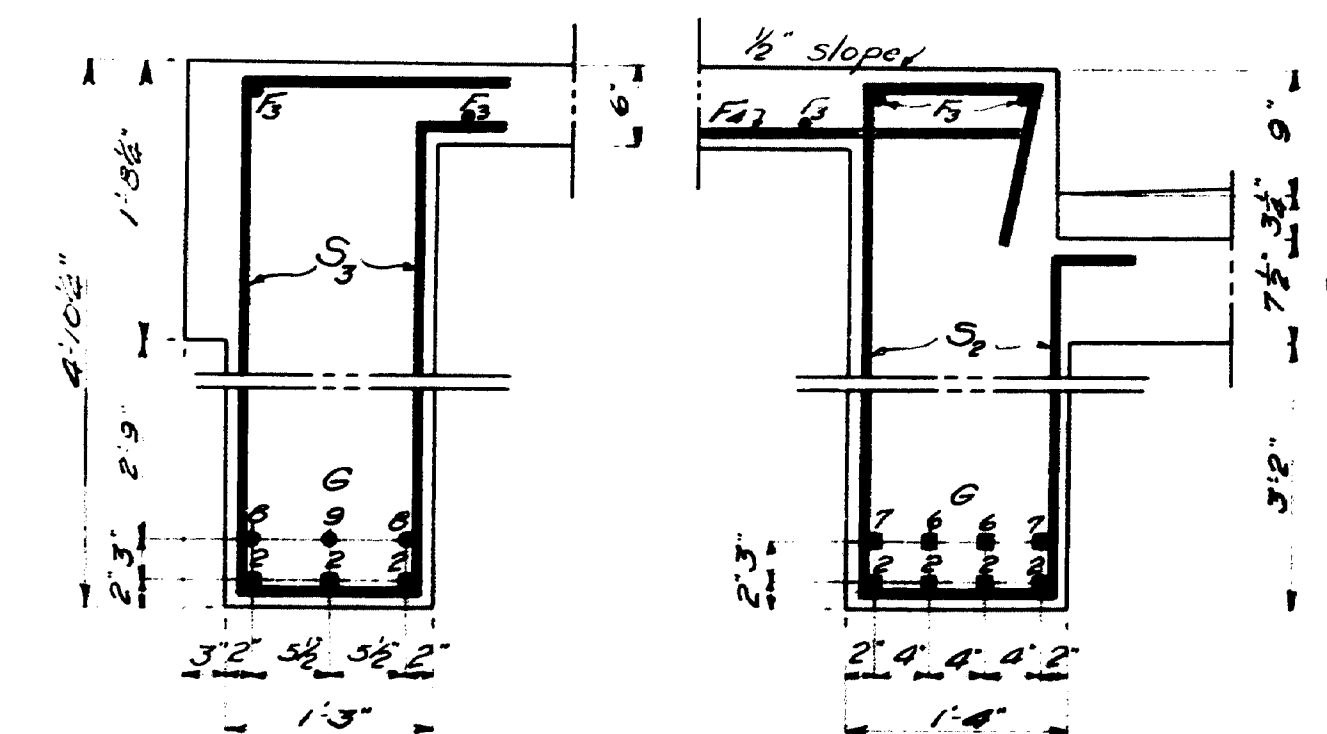

INTERIOR GIRDERS.



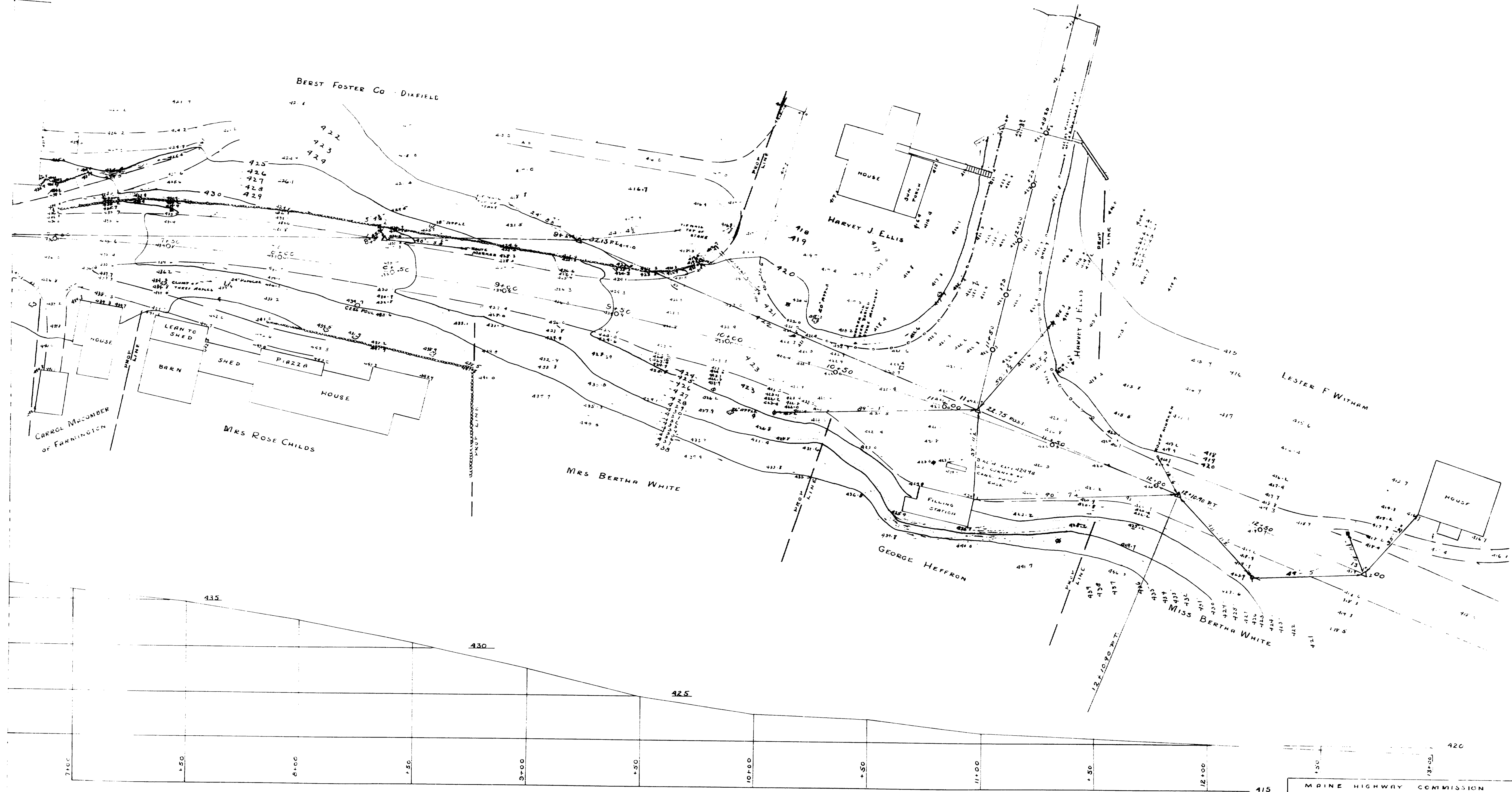
EXT. ROADWAY GIRDER.

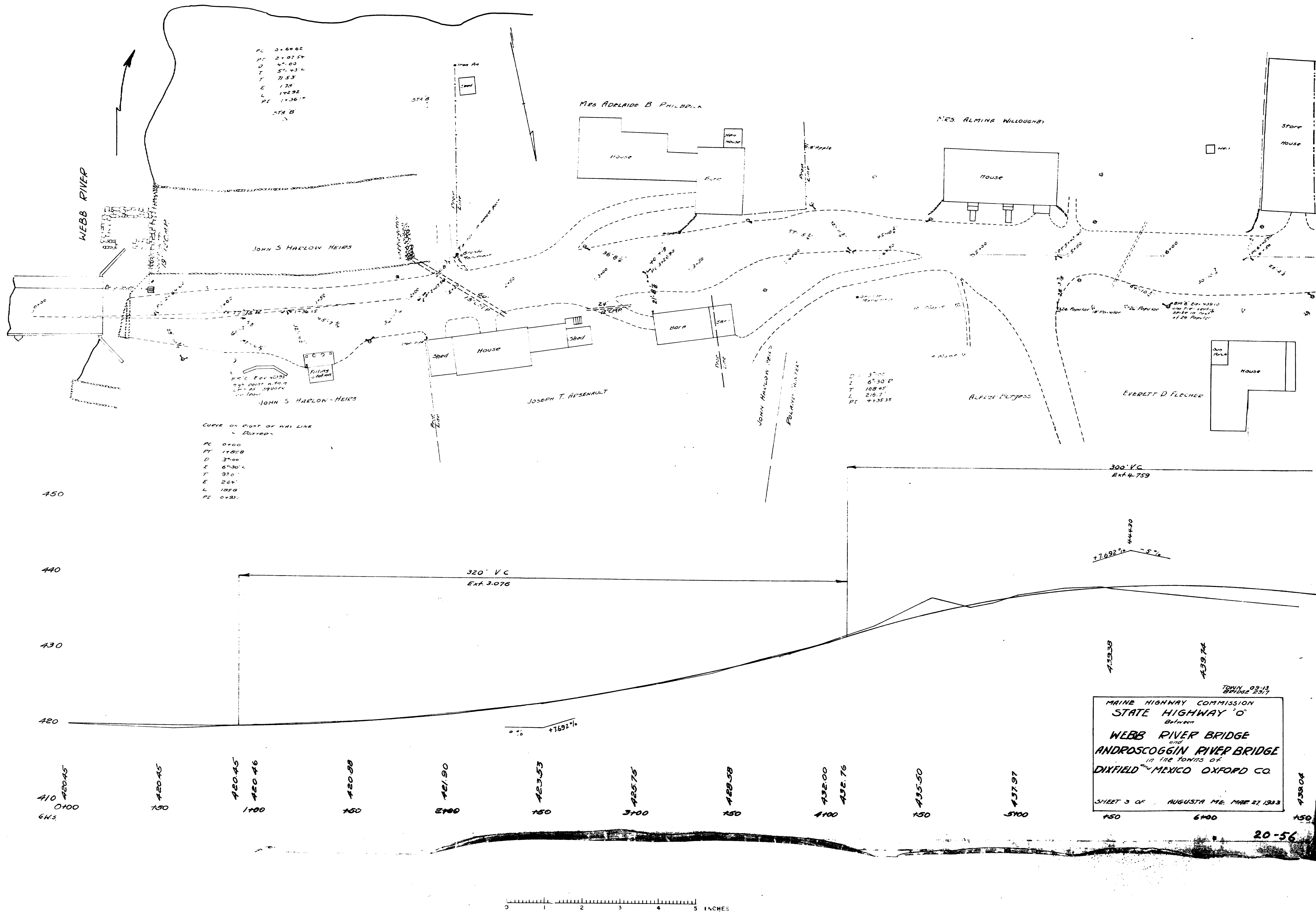
