The following questions have been received:

Question: Does item 606.365 Remove Modify Reset, require 7' post (new) for part of the modification? Or just new 3c 606.23 requires 7' post?

Response: 7 foot posts are not required.

Question: PIN 17289.00 Baring plan sheet #2 of 25, Note #6 states "Mill and Shim as necessary to achieve the proposed design cross slopes and grades as shown on the plans and directed by the Resident. Shim shall be incidental to the milling." Is the intent to make shim "incidental" to the milling? There is an item in the project for shim. Should we use this item for the above specified work?

Response: For Win # 17289.00, the shim is incidental to the milling as stated in note # 6 on page 2
