The following questions have been received:

Question: Are Frangible or collapsible couplings required for the Power or AWOS Equipment support racks?

Response: Frangible couplings are not required. All equipment is outside of protected object free areas and safety areas

Question: What is the "Class" of the Traffic Rated junction boxes?

Response: Junction boxes shall be rated for AASHTO H10 loading.

Question: Specifications call for 22kAIC rated panels at equipment racks. In Princeton, the upstream protective devices are only 10kAIC rated. Is a 10kAIC rating at the Equipment rack acceptable?

Response: For PNN, 10kAIC at the equipment rack is acceptable based on the upstream source power ratings.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on April 9, 2025.
