Dear Sir/Ms.:

The following question has been received:

**Question:** In accordance with Special Provisions Section 104 Utilities, we are notifying the Department that the existing utility lines do not provide the 10-foot minimum clearance required for complying with M.R.S.A. Title35-A, Chapter 7-A Sections 751-761 Overhead High-Voltage Line Safety Act. The utility lines currently provide approximately 2 feet of clearance of the bridge fascia.

**Response:** Central Maine Power can adjust their power line away from the bridge by no more than 10 feet if requested by the Contractor. The power line must remain energized but can be covered if requested. At pre-construction, the Contractor may request these lines be moved and can expect 2 weeks before work is completed, as is stated in Special Provision – Section 104 – Utilities, under the AERIAL heading.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **January 3, 2018**.
