Please make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book:

**REMOVE** pages 27 – 34, Contract, Agreement, Offer & Award, 8 pages, and **REPLACE** with the attached, revised Contract, Agreement, Offer & Award, 8 pages.

**REMOVE** page 92, SPECIAL PROVISION - SECTION 107 - PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS - (Contract Time), 1 page, dated March 21, 2018, and **REPLACE** with the attached, revised SPECIAL PROVISION - SECTION 107 - PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS - (Contract Time), 1 page, dated April 17, 2018.

The following questions have been received:

**Question:** Is it the Intent of the Department to pave both Northbound & Southbound Rest Areas in Medway?

**Response:** Southbound rest area only.

**Question:** Working back from the Completion date of September 22, 2018 using the 150 CD's given in the contract the start date would be April 26, 2018, which is only 1 week after the job bids. Would the Department consider extending the completion date to allow the Contractor to utilize all CD given in the contract once the award is given and a start date is established?

**Response:** Extended to October 6<sup>th</sup>. Please see attached updated Special Provision 107, and Contract, Agreement, Offer & Award.



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**Question:** Special Provision Section 403 shows item 403.2131 12.5mm HMA Base being placed at 3" thick on a Bridge Deck. Which Bridge Deck will this item be used on at 3" depth?

**Response:** All three of the paved bridges. Depending on contractor sequence of operations, either the 3 inches of base will be micro milled to accommodate the UTWBC or the base will be placed 2 ¼ inches thick then UTWBC placed on top.

**Question:** On page 3 of the Construction Notes it states in the South Bound Rest Area that there will be various locations milled at 1.5" for approx. 4,000 SY. What HMA item will be used to pave in these Areas?

**Response:** 403.211 and 403.2104.

**Question:** Where will the 90 TN of 403.213 12.5mm HMA Base be used?

**Response:** WIN 18824.00 on the pipe trench.

**Question:** Special Provision Section 105 note 7 states after 7 calendar days any milled areas not covered in need of extra repair or maintenance shall be repaired at the expense of the Contractor. However, Note 16 in the same 105 Section states the Department requests the travel lane be milled prior to the passing Lane. Will the Department waive Special Provision Section 105 note 7 given they are requesting the travel lane be milled first, and possibly will not get covered with mix for an extended period of time?


**Response:** The travel way micro mill can be left open for up to 21 days.

**Question:** Will the department allow multiple paving and milling operations as long as the department has sufficient notice?

**Response:** With sufficient notice this will be allowed. Please allow up to 7 calendar days to fulfill the request.

## CONTRACT AGREEMENT, OFFER & AWARD

The Department and the Contractor, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this Agreement (the "Contract"), hereby agree as follows:

### **A. The Work.**

The Contractor agrees to complete all Work as specified or indicated in the Contract including Extra Work in conformity with the Contract, **WINs 18797.00, 18824.00, & 22318.00 for the Pavement Milling, Hot Mix Asphalt Overlay, Bridge Rehabilitation, Ultra-Thin Bonded Wearing Course, with Drainage and Safety Improvements in the Towns of Medway and Sherman and Townships of T1 R6 WELS, Herseytown and Benedicta, Counties of Aroostook and Penobscot, Maine.** The Work includes construction, maintenance during construction, warranty as provided in the Contract, and other incidental work.

The Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing all supervision, labor, equipment, tools supplies, permanent materials and temporary materials required to perform the Work including construction quality control including inspection, testing and documentation, all required documentation at the conclusion of the project, warranting its work and performing all other work indicated in the Contract.

The Department shall have the right to alter the nature and extent of the Work as provided in the Contract; payment to be made as provided in the same.

### **B. Time.**

The Contractor agrees to complete all Work, except warranty work, on or before **October 6, 2018.** Further, the Department may deduct from moneys otherwise due the Contractor, not as a penalty, but as Liquidated Damages in accordance with Sections 107.7 and 107.8 of the State of Maine Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, November 2014 Edition and related Special Provisions.

SECTION 107  
PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS  
(Contract Time)

The Contractor may begin work **Anytime** in accordance with Standard Specification 104.4.2 and upon approval of all required submittals. The Contract Completion Date will be no later than **October 6, 2018.**

At least 21 calendar days prior to the desired Begin Construction Date the Contractor shall submit an **electronic copy of their signed request to begin work and the Begin Construction Date.** This signed request shall be sent read receipt through **email** with their **Schedule of Work**, in accordance with Standard Specification 107.4.2, to **[Shawn.Smith@Maine.gov](mailto:Shawn.Smith@Maine.gov)**, **[Emory.Lovely@Maine.gov](mailto:Emory.Lovely@Maine.gov)**, and **[Scott.Bickford@Maine.gov](mailto:Scott.Bickford@Maine.gov)**. The Contractor shall notify all utility contacts listed in the 104 Special Provision and provide the utility contacts the submitted schedule of work within 2 calendar days of the schedule of work submittal. **A penalty in the amount of \$500/day will be assessed for each calendar day or partial calendar day beyond June 15<sup>th</sup> that the schedule of work is not received.** Upon receipt of the schedule of work, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. A Contract Modification will be executed to document the new Contract Completion Date based upon the Begin Construction Date. The modified Contract Completion Date shall not exceed the Contract Completion Date specified in this special provision.

The Contractor may request to adjust the submitted schedule of work and Begin Construction Date once after the initial submittal. The Department will allow adjustments in the Begin Construction Date of up to **seven calendar days** if the request is made at least **21 calendar days** prior to the updated Begin Construction Date. This signed request shall be sent read receipt through **email** with their **Schedule of Work**, in accordance with Standard Specification 107.4.2, to **[Shawn.Smith@Maine.gov](mailto:Shawn.Smith@Maine.gov)**, **[Emory.Lovely@Maine.gov](mailto:Emory.Lovely@Maine.gov)**, and **[Scott.Bickford@Maine.gov](mailto:Scott.Bickford@Maine.gov)**.
