Make the following change to the Bid Document:

In the Bid Book (page 97) "SPECIAL PROVISION, SECTION 631 EQUIPMENT RENTAL, (PAVING CREW)" under "EQUIPMENT", "631.031 Loading and Hauling Equipment:" **CHANGE** "Truck loading and hauling will be done by the State." to read "**Truck loading and hauling will be done by the CONTRACTOR.**" Make this change in pen and ink.

The following questions have been received:

Question: Where is the existing RAP pile? Is there sufficient area to process the RAP at the pile?


Response: The RAP pile is on RTE 9/126 about a mile past the MDOT maintenance lot in West Gardiner as you head towards Lewiston. It will be up to the Contractor's discretion whether or not the existing RAP location can accommodate a crushing operation. If the site is not large enough for the Contractor's crushing operation the RAP shall be picked up and hauled by the Contractor to the MDOT lot in West Gardiner where there is plenty of room for crushing and the Pug Mill.

Question: In Special Provision 631 –Equipment Rental, it states "Truck loading and hauling will be done by the State." Item 310.21 is Plant Mixed Recycled Asphalt Pavement – Mixing and Trucking. Please clarify.

Response: Special Provision 631 should state "truck loading and hauling shall be done by the CONTRACTOR". Please see the above pen and ink change

Consider this change and information prior to submitting your bid on July 11, 2012.
