SPECIAL PROVISION
SECTION 105
GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK
(Limitations of Operations)

Permitted work days are Monday through Saturday. The Contractor shall not work on Sundays and Holidays.

Maintain two-way traffic at all times on Civic Center Drive (Route 27). Minimum lane width shall be 11'. Lane closures on Civic Center Drive shall only be allowed at night between 9:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. Maximum allowable closure length shall be 1500'.

Interstate 95 ramp closures shall only be allowed from 11:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Traffic shall not be allowed to queue into I-95 through lanes. Variable message signs shall be installed at I-95 interchanges north and south of Exit 112 and in each direction on Civic Center Drive at the next major intersections beyond the project limits. Messages shall include notification of closures.
