Question: Would the Department consider extending the road closure window past the August 31st deadline for at least one or both locations?

Response: The Department would allow a closure extension on WIN 21685.00, West Chapman Road, as per attached SPECIAL PROVISION - SECTION 105 - (LIMITATION OF OPERATIONS).

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**SPECIAL PROVISION
SECTION 105
(LIMITATION OF OPERATIONS)**

1. The Contractor shall plan operations such that the Resident will have sufficient advance notification to provide the necessary inspection and testing. Sufficient advance notification will be considered 48 hours.
2. The Contractor will be allowed a 14-day road closure at each of the Large Culvert project locations, closures will not be permitted to be closed simultaneously. The roads shall be closed no sooner than 9:00 AM on the first day and reopened to a minimum of one-way alternating traffic no later than 3:00 PM on or before September 21, 2018 (West Chapman Road). The approved Detour Plan and Sign Summary can be found on Pages 13 and 14 within each of the Contract Plan Sets, respectively. The Contractor shall be responsible for the coordination of the road closure as specified in MaineDOT Standard Specifications, Section 104.4.10 Coordination of Road Closure/Bridge Closure/Bridge Width Restriction Notification. For each calendar day beyond the 14-day limit that the road is closed the Contractor will be charged Liquidated Damages per diem according to MaineDOT Standard Specifications, Section 107.7.2 Schedule of Liquidated Damages.
3. The Contractor shall provide a 48-hour notice prior to working any Saturdays.
