REMOVE page 51, SPECIAL PROVISION - SECTION 104 - GENERAL RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES - (Bridge Closure Notification), 1 page, dated March 12, 2018, and **REPLACE** with the attached, revised SPECIAL PROVISION - SECTION 104 - GENERAL RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES - (Bridge Closure Notification), 1 page, dated March 29, 2018.

ADD the attached SPECIAL PROVISION - SECTION 105 - GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK - (Limitations of Operations) for Caribou, WIN 21681.00, 1 page, dated 2/1/2018.

ADD the attached SPECIAL PROVISION - SECTION 105 - GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK - (Limitations of Operations) for Masardis, WIN 21737.00, 1 page, dated 2/7/2018.

Question: Special Provision section 7: the painting work shall not start on the Masardis project until 9/15/18. Is this restriction only on bridge #3766?

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SPECIAL PROVISION
SECTION 104
GENERAL RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES
(Bridge Closure Notification)

Section 104, General Rights and Responsibilities, of the Standard Specifications is amended as follows:

104.4.10 Coordination of Bridge Closure/Bridge Width Restriction Notification:

Paragraph 2 is removed and replaced with the following:

A public notice shall be published in a local newspaper ten day prior to the closure.

SPECIAL PROVISION
SECTION 105
GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK
(Limitations of Operations)

Daily lane closures are allowed. The Contractor may close the two outside lanes of the bridge. The Contractor must maintain, at a minimum, one 13-foot wide lane of traffic in each direction on the bridge for the duration of the project. Long term lane closures are allowed with the use of concrete jersey barriers to protect the work zone.

SPECIAL PROVISION
SECTION 105
GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK
(Limitations of Operations)

The Contractor shall at a minimum maintain one 11-foot lane of alternating traffic for the duration of the project.
