Dear Sir/Ms.:

Please make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book:

REMOVE pages 13-14, Proposal Schedule of Items, 2 pages dated 3/25/2021, and **REPLACE** with the attached, revised Proposal Schedule of Items, 3 pages, dated 4/7/2021.

DELETE on page 33, "CONSTRUCTION NOTES", notes for items 629.05, 631.12 and 631.172. Make this change in pen and ink.

CHANGE on page 67, "SPECIAL PROVISION - SECTION 107 - (Contract Time)", Note 5, which begins with "The Contractor shall be allowed to commence work after sunrise..." to read:

"When the detour is not in place, the Contractor shall be allowed to commence work after sunrise and shall be completely off the road before sunset. Sunrise and sunset will be determined according to the Sunrise/Sunset Table at <http://www.sunrisesunset.com/usa/Maine>. If the project town is not listed, the closest town on the list will be used as agreed." Make this change in pen and ink.

The following questions have been received:

Question: Item 631.172 "Truck - Large (Including Operator)" is not part of the "Schedule of Items".

Response: See revised Schedule of Items.

Question: Please explain more clearly the following "Equipment Rental Items are intended for use while placing streambed material." Are Items 203.33 "Special Fill", 610.210 "Stream Channel Rock" and 610.212 "Streambed Rock Features" for delivered materials only?

Response: See above changes to Construction Notes.

Question: Special Provision Section 107 (Contract Time), does note 5 only apply to days worked outside of the closure periods?

Response: See above change to SPECIAL PROVISION - SECTION 107 - (Contract Time).

Question: Special Provision Section 107 (Contract Time), please provide more clarification to note 9. Pipe 4 is going to be difficult to get produced for the 2021 season this late in the spring (sometime after April 21st for an award). The Contractor's best price may be to push this culvert into the 2022 season. How will the Department determine the 2021 schedule is unattainable? Does the Contractor go with a higher price from a vendor if they claim they can get it produced in time for 2021?

Response: The Department will accept letters from manufacturers stating that the box cannot be built this year in time to have it installed in the allotted time.

Question: Since the material is different for the Box Culvert and the Arch culvert, can the State provide quantities for each for Items 203.33 "Special Fill" and 610.212 "Streambed Rock Features"?

Response: Box: 203.33 Approximately 130CY 610.212 Approximately 12CY
Arch: 203.33 Approximately 65CY 610.212 Approximately 40CY
