The following questions have been received:

**Question:** Can the Department provide slope sheets for the profile milling?

**Response:** The Department will provide the Contractor with cross slope sheets for profile milling, CIPR, and shim placement at the time of award.

**Question:** Where does the Department plan to establish the control point for Milling?

**Response:** Centerline will be the control point for milling and will be designated on the slope sheets when provided.

**Question:** What is the Departments plan on the CIP at night when you have high humidity and it's not setting up, before having to opening the road up to traffic?

**Response:** The Department is not aware of any previous instances where this has been an issue. If encountered, it will be handled accordingly by the Resident.

**Question:** Where is Item 403.213 12.5mm base located?

**Response:** Please refer to Typical Sheet 2 of 7 of WIN 23749.00.

**Question:** Where is Item 203.20 Common Excavation located?

**Response:** Please refer to Typical Sheet 2 of 7 of WIN 23749.00.

**Question:** Is there a specific location for the stock pilings of millings to be used on-site as needed?

**Response:** There is no specific location for stock piling millings on-site. They will be used as designated in the Construction Notes.

**Question:** Does the Department intend for the project to be completed in 2021?

**Response:** The Department intends for the contract to be completed within 112 Working Days. This will likely extend into 2022. Please also reference Special Provision 101 and Special Provision 403, Note 41.

**Question:** What will the over lap of the CIP be on the center match-up and the transition from main line to shoulder?

**Response:** Please reference Special Provision 311 and the Typical Sections.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **June 2, 2021**.
