Make the following changes to the Bid Book:

In the Bid Book:

Remove pages 17 to 20 titled Proposal Schedule of items dated 11/2/2023 and **Replace** with the attached Proposal Schedule of items dated 11/13/2023 totaling four page

The following questions have been received:

Question: Can you please clarify if the excavation of the existing riprap is incidental? The earthwork summary within the drawings specifies the quantity of anticipated riprap excavation, but the quantity for the common excavation pay item appears to be only for the roadway area excavation.

Response: Riprap excavation is shown on the Earthwork Summary to quantify the amount of surplus material on the project. Per Standard Specification 610.06, excavation for riprap is incidental to the pay item.

Question: IN a previous RFI Response the department stated that existing Heavy Rip Rap may be reused. However the department did not state whether the re-handling and reuse of the existing Heavy Rip Rap would be paid under the Heavy Rip Rap item; or if it would be considered a common excavation or common borrow item. Please advise if reused Heavy Rip Rap will be paid under that item; and if so; what types of lengths should the contractor go to regarding separating the unsuitable material surrounding the existing rip-rap. Will it be up to the department or the contractor whether existing rip-rap is reused?

Response: Please see Standard Specification 104.3.13. The removal outside of the incidental excavation limits will be paid under common excavation. If the contractor elects to reuse acceptable material, it will be paid under the appropriate pay item – in this case Heavy Riprap. It is the contractor's choice as to what efforts they put into reusing existing material

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on December 13, 2023.
