REMOVE page 28, 2021 Fair Minimum Wage Rates - Heavy & Bridge Statewide, 1 page, , and **REPLACE** with the attached 2022 Fair Minimum Wage Rates - Heavy & Bridge Knox, Lincoln, and Sagadahoc Counties (3 pages). The individual project locations shall determine which County Wage Rates apply to the work performed at each individual location.

The following questions have been received:

Question: The final plan set for WIN 024603.00 includes sheets 1 of 9 thru 7 of 9 but does not include a sheet 8 or sheet 9. Are there two additional sheets that are missing, and if so - can you please provide these?

Response: The plan set for WIN 024603.00 is complete on the MaineDOT web site. The page numbers start with G01 and G02, and then have pages S01 – S07, which is 9 pages. Please see SHEET NUMBER G01(1 OF 9), TITLE SHEET for the “INDEX OF SHEETS”

Question: Is there a DBE% goal for this project and an engineering estimate?
