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SPECIAL PROVISION

SECTION 107

TIME

(Contract Time)

1. The Contractor shall be allowed to commence Work on the Contract on or after **June 4, 2018** provided that the Contract has been awarded, all required plans/submittals have been received and determined to be acceptable by the Department and a preconstruction meeting has been held.
2. The specified Contract Completion Date is **September 30, 2018**.
3. Once the Contractor commences work, they will have 14 calendar days to complete the project. For everyday over the 14 calendar days allotted it takes to complete the project, the contractor will be charged Supplemental Liquidated Damages at the rates given for liquidated damages in Section 107.7.2 of the Standard Specifications.
4. The Contractor shall not Work on **July 4, 2018**, due to the observance of Independence Day holiday.
5. The Contractor shall stop Work on **August 31, 2018 at 3:00 PM** and shall not resume Work until **September 4, 2018**, due to the observance of Labor Day holiday weekend.
6. No work will be allowed on Saturdays or Sundays.
7. Unless properly equipped with lighting and protective gear as per the MUTCD, the Contractor is only allowed to commence work and end work daily according to the Sunrise/Sunset Table at <http://www.sunrisesunset.com/usa/Maine.asp>. If the project town is not listed, the closest town on the list will be used as agreed.
