The following questions have been received:

Question:

- Proposal Schedule of Items lines 0130 and 0140 call for Polymer Coated Pipe
- Special provision Section 603 references Polymer
- Grand Lake Rd and Hay Lake Bridge Sheet 5 of 14 in Structural Plate Note 2. References Polymer Coated
- Both structural plate notes in item one requires five gage at or below the waterline.
- Corrugated metal pipe comes in Polymer coated, but not thicker than 10 gage.
- Galvanized structural plate can be produced in 5 gage. Would galvanized material be acceptable?

Response:

- On sheet 5 of 14 on both plan sets, strike Note #1 (omit all references to structural plate arch)
- For these locations, the department prefers Polymer coated pipe arch as per SP603 for both Large Culvert Wins.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **April 16, 2025**.
