The following question has been received:

**Question:** In the 350 areas that the spray paver will not be able to reach while paving main line. Will the department allow conventional HMA and if so will it be paid by the square as UTBW?

**Response:** The Contractor shall submit a bid according to the Contract Documents. However, the Department may allow the use of a 9.5 mm HMA surface meeting the requirements of a thin lift mixture in the 350 areas. Should the Contractor propose using an HMA for those locations, then a Contract Modification will be required to memorialize the agreement and any adjustments to be made to the basis of payment, limits of work, or method of testing.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **April 7, 2021**.
