Dear Sir/Ms.:

The following questions have been received:

**Question:** The project description in the notice to contractors indicates that the project ends at River Road "US Route 302 in Windham beginning at US Rt 202 and extending 2.82 miles to River Road". However, 2.82 miles from Rt 202 is the intersection of Rt 35/115. The project location map (page 34 of the bid book) indicates that the project ends at Rt 115/35 however the green highlight for the project work area ends at approximately River Road. The project title sheet (page 33) and the project stationing (page 44) indicate that the project ends at Rt 35/115. Where does the project end and do the quantities in the schedule of items reflect the correct project end location.

**Response:** The project ends at the intersection with Rte 35/115. From the River Road to Rte 35/115 will be a shim only. The main project ends at the River Road.

**Question:** Could the guardrail work on this project be done during the day by moving the traffic over enough to work and not requiring a night-time lane closure?

**Response:** Special Provision Section 105 states, "Lane closures are only allowed between 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM, Sunday night to Friday." There are no restrictions against lane shifts during daytime work.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **May 17, 2023**.
