Dear Sir/Ms.:

The following questions have been received:

**Question:** If ledge is encountered, how will removal be paid? Similarly, how will rock anchoring of wood poles be paid, if required?

**Response:** No subsurface exploration was completed for this project. However, a field review of each site location was completed and determined that shallow ledge was unlikely (but not impossible) within 7 feet of the ground surface. If the Contractor encounters ledge at 7 feet or deeper at any location, the ledge removal and/or rock anchoring will be considered incidental to Item 643.972. If the Contractor encounters ledge at less than 7 feet below grade, the Contractor may submit a Notice of Issue for Consideration in accordance with Section 109.4.

**Question:** Is a remote power management (RPM) unit required in the cabinets?

**Response:** No, remote power management (RPM) units are not a requirement of the contract. If the Contractor determines that an RPM unit is appropriate for the operation of the RWIS equipment proposed, the Contractor has the option to furnish and install an RPM as incidental to the cost of the RWIS equipment.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **September 24, 2025**.
