The following questions have been received:

Question: Can you clarify the building design sizes and number of garage doors. Section 815 Page 4 General requirements.

Response: Refer to pages 35 – 43 of the Bid Book. The gable ends of the building in Enfield shall be 42' wide from outside edge to outside edge of concrete. The gable ends of the building in Jonesboro shall be 40' wide from outside edge to outside edge of concrete. The length of both buildings shall be 40' from outside edge to outside edge of concrete. The Enfield garage shall have 2- 10'x 10' overhead garage doors. The Jonesboro garage shall have 1-10'x10' overhead garage door.

Question: After reading through specs it seems there is no additions to the scope since last time. Please confirm.

Response: The Department added the option to bid one or both buildings. Refer to Special Provision 815 General Requirements, page 90, #11 of the Bid Book. "A vapor barrier shall be installed under the concrete slab". It is the responsibility of the Bidder to review the bid book for any changes prior to bidding.

Question: Is a halfway break acceptable in plexiglass window? (w/trim)

Response: Yes.

Question: If one contractor wins both garages will there be two separate contracts?

Response: No.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **July 15, 2020**.
