Dear Sir/Ms.:

The following questions have been received:

Question: Who will be responsible for Supervision, Flaggers, Signs, Daily Sign Packages, Layout, Traffic Control, Project Facilities and Erosion Control?

Response: Not sure what is meant by Project Facilities but all other items are the responsibilities of Maine DOT

Question: Will Centerline be painted out by others, or is it the responsibility of the General Contractor, if by the General Contractor what will they be able to utilize for centerline control and what will the spacing or amount of control provided by others be from the prior contracts?

Response: Centerline will be painted out by MaineDOT

Question: Will the spot shim areas be laid out prior to the September 5th start date?

Response: Any areas requiring spot shims will be identified prior to paving operations beginning.

Question: Are spot shims meant to be placed over the 12.5mm base areas or to drag over any rough areas from the injection process?

Response: Spot shims are intended to correct any areas of grade or slope deficiencies in the FDR layer prior to the placement of the 12.5mm base layer.

Question: Any widenings or sideroads being paved, if so, how many, and rough SY for those areas?

Response: No side roads are expected to be paved

Question: Is Guardrail being installed prior to paving or after?

Response: Expectation is the guardrail will be placed after the paving

Question: Will the MDOT be providing laydown yards along this project to stage equipment and materials?

Response: No but there are several laydown yards the clearing contractor used and MaineDOT has a gravel stockpile yard on site that the Contractor can use.

Question: Is the base paving being completed via grade or meeting cross slopes?

Response: Meeting cross slope
