Dear Sir/Ms.:

The following questions have been received:

Question: Is a 100 watt Rittal heater in the LCP acceptable?

Response: No. A 400-watt Rittal (or equivalent) heater is required in the MDP enclosure to minimize condensation.

Question: There is a PDF file included with the bid documents "cx026824.00" that shows a concrete roadway and concrete parapet walls along the top of the breakwater. It appears that this does not apply? Please clarify?

Response: This project was previously advertised and that design included a concrete roadway and parapet walls on the top of the breakwater. The current design does not. These documents are included for informational purposes for the rubble breakwater design/construction.

Question: There is a specification for life rings indicating that they will be paid per each yet there is no bid item for these?

Response: There are no life rings required under the contract. Please DELETE page 196, Section 853 Maritime (Life Rings), in the Contract Book.

Question: Is the 12" Gravel bedding and geotextile fabric beneath the boat ramp planks incidental to the boat ramp or are they paid per other items?

Response: The boat ramp gravel bedding is quantified in Item 411.09 (UNTREATED AGGREGATE SURFACE COURSE - TYPE B (Boat Ramp + Uplands Transition)). Please note that the total quantity for 411.09 also includes civil/upland quantities. Geotextile fabric for the boat ramp (and breakwater) is included in Item 620.60 (SEPARATION GEOTEXTILE (Non-Woven, Boat Ramp, Rubble Mound to parking lot interface)).

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on **May 6, 2026**.
