The following questions have been received:

**Question:** Will the department allow the contractor to utilize temporary steel barrier for the temp barrier to help expedite the installation and movement of barrier on this contract?

**Response:** The Department may accept temporary steel barrier provided that the barrier is MASH compliant, applicable for use in a high-speed interstate setting and meeting manufacturer's recommended use and application. The Contractor shall submit the type of steel barrier to be used for the Department review, comment, and approval.

**Question:** If allowed to use temporary steel barrier what will the department allow for filling the holes left by the anchors used with the barrier?

**Response:** The Contractor shall submit a urethane or asphaltic mastic product for review and approval by the Department prior to filling the holes created by the anchors.
