## SPECIAL PROVISION <u>SECTION 105</u> General Scope of Work (Environmental Requirements)

To protect the Peregrin Falcon a state Endangered species:

There is an active peregrine falcon nest on the ledges east of Bear Pond, Waterford adjacent to paving activities on Rt. 35. Maine DOT environmental staff are required to routinely monitor the nest site before, during, and after construction activities. Therefore, the contractor must notify Chris Robinson of the MaineDOT Environmental Office (207-215-7739) at least 1 week prior to the start of construction activities near Bear Pond between the Rt 37/ Rt 35 intersection (44.146323, - 70.708443) and the Cross St/ Rt 35 intersection (44.160624, -70.717320). Further coordination with MaineDOT environmental staff may be required during this time.
