SPECIAL PROVISION <u>SECTION 107</u> PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS (Contract Time – Light Capital Paving)

The Contractor may begin work anytime on or after <u>May 5th, 2025.</u> in accordance with Standard Specification 104.4.2 and upon approval of all required submittals. The contract completion date will be <u>October 3rd, 2025</u>. Work added to or deleted from the Contract will increase or decrease at a rate of 1 day per 250 tons. A revised schedule of work shall be submitted and approved for these changes.

Paving will be allowed on Saturday if the Contractor chooses to provide all Traffic Control at no additional cost and a minimum 48-hour notice is given. Traffic control for all work after the completion date will be supplied by the contractor at no additional cost to the Department.

At least 21 calendar days prior to the desired Begin Construction Date the Contractor shall submit an electronic copy of their signed request to begin work and the Begin Construction Date. This signed request shall be sent read receipt through email with their Schedule of Work, in accordance Specification 107.4.2, Timothy.Pelotte@Maine.gov, with Standard to Emory.Lovely@Maine.gov and Harvey.Smith@Maine.gov. The approved Schedule of Work will detail the anticipated working days and show a completion within the allowable working times. The Contractor shall notify all utility contacts listed in the 104 Special Provision and provide the utility contacts the submitted schedule of work within 2 calendar days of the schedule of work submittal. A penalty in the amount of \$500/day will be assessed for each calendar day or partial calendar day beyond June 15th that the schedule of work is not received. Upon receipt of the schedule of work, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled.

No work is allowed to take place during the months of July and August.

No work is allowed on September 25th, 2025
