Station (LT) 83+68 to 86+83

**Question:** In the areas where the spray paver will not fit, will the department allow the use of a conventional paver and 9.5mm polymer mix?

**Response:** The department would allow the use of a 9.5mm polymer surface mixture to be placed on shoulders in areas where a UTBWC spray paver may not typically reach the required width in one pass; normally 4 foot, and up to 5 foot shoulder widths. Payment shall be made under item 462.301 for any 9.5mm polymer surface mix placed on the shoulders. The department may consider the use of a 9.5mm non-polymer mixture for use on the shoulders but would require a credit for the use of a non-polymer mixture.

**Question:** Will the millings become property of the contractor?

Response: Yes, the millings will become the property of the contractor
